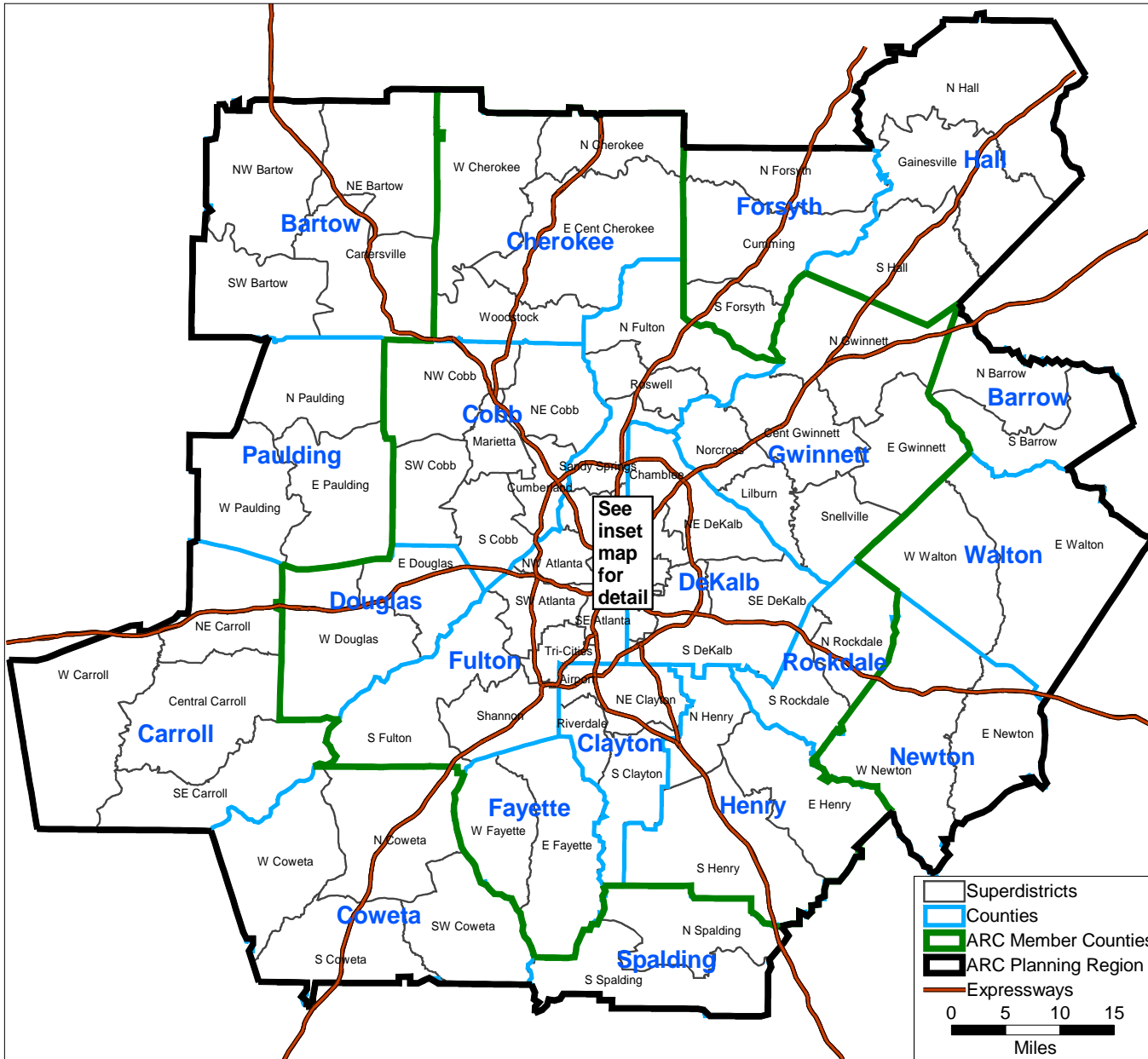
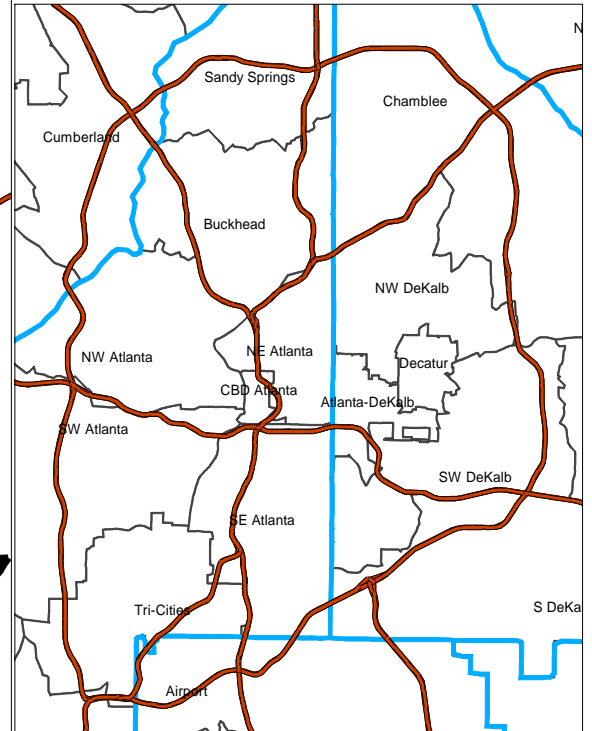


# Atlanta Area Superdistricts



**Inset Map: Inside the Perimeter**



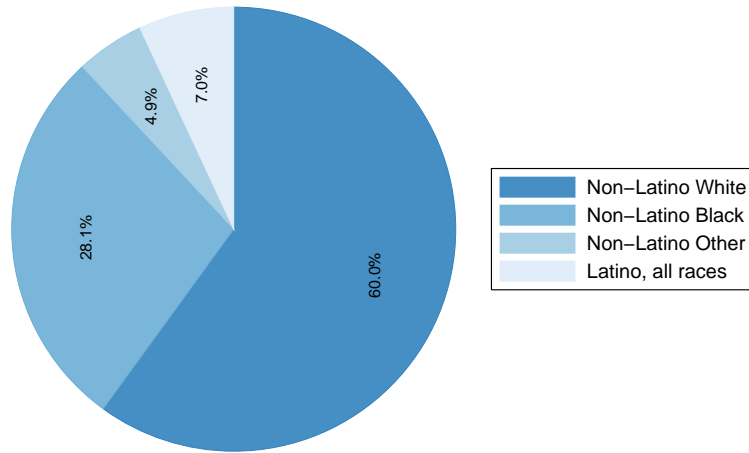

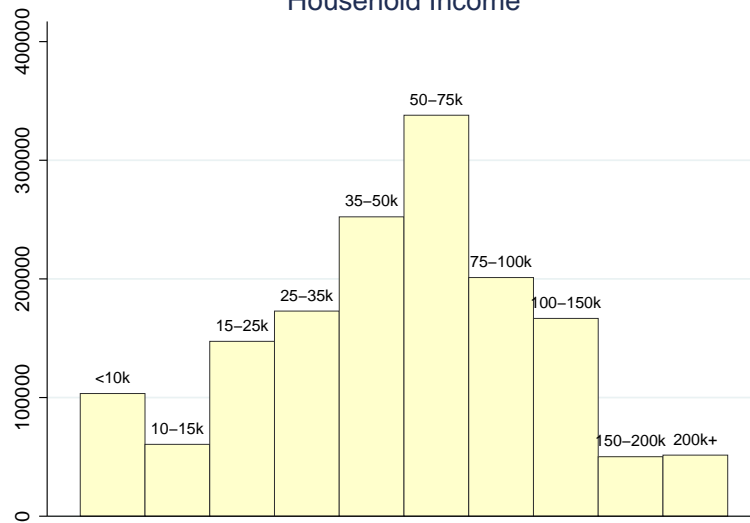

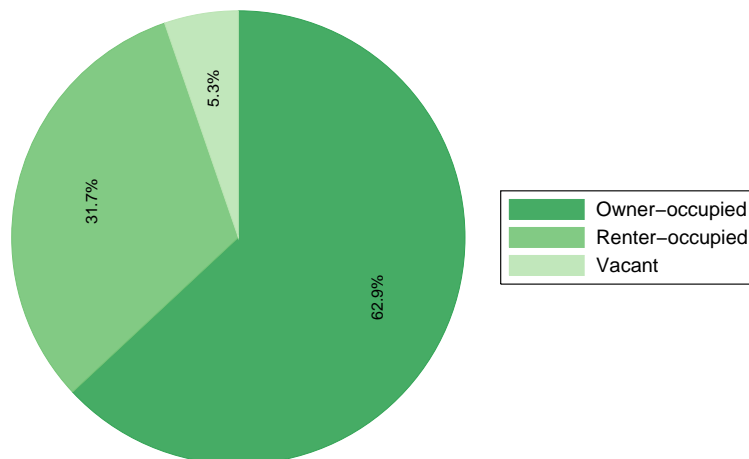
### Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin
