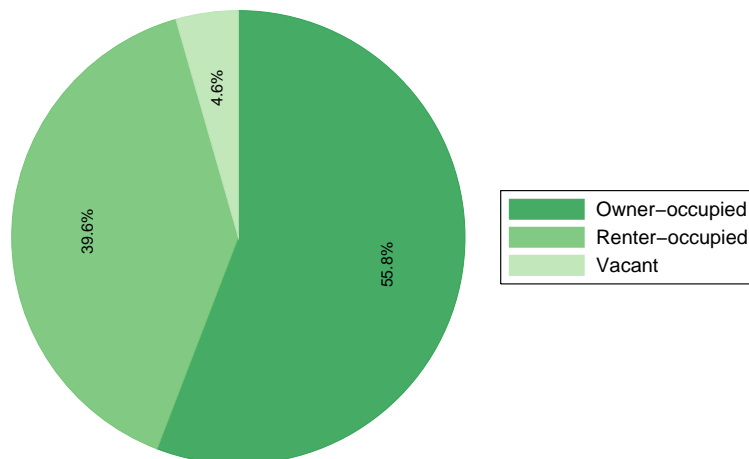
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

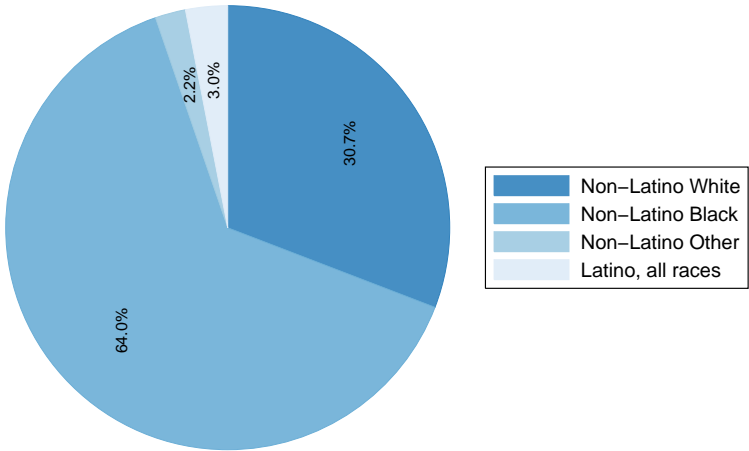

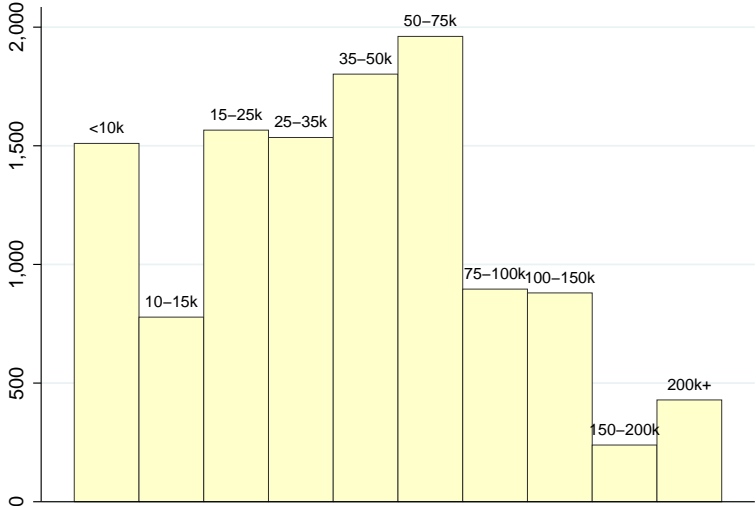

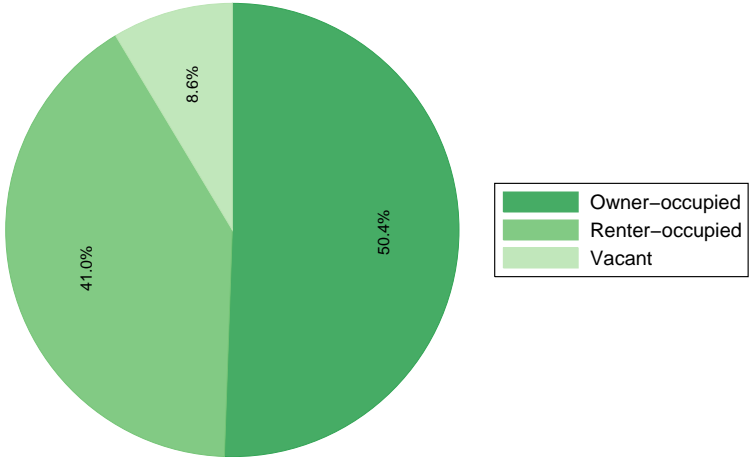
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

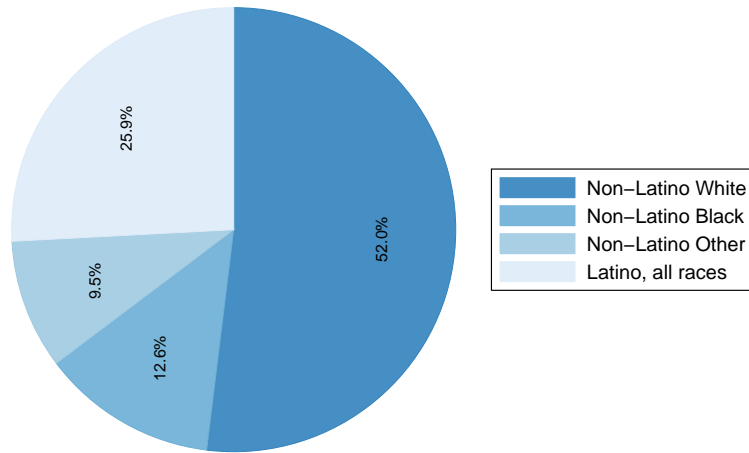

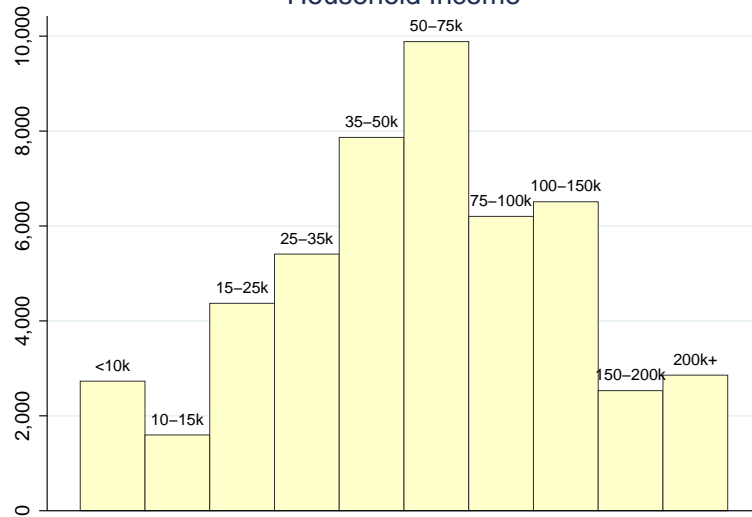

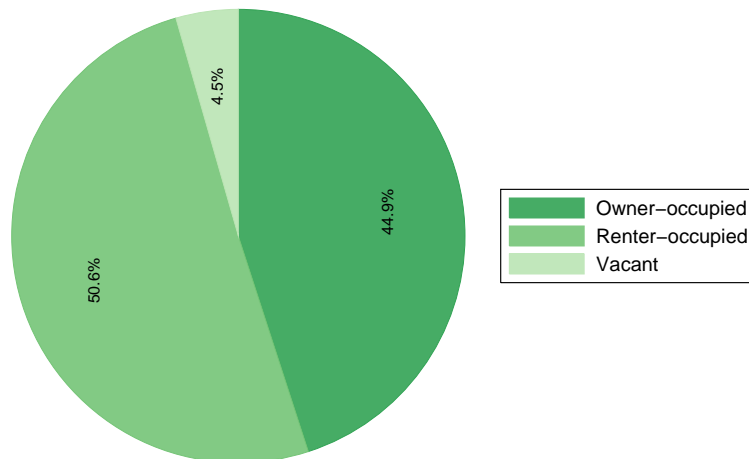
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

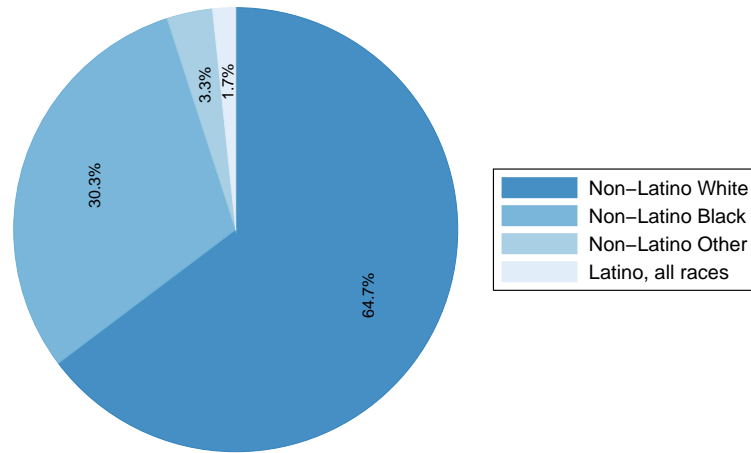

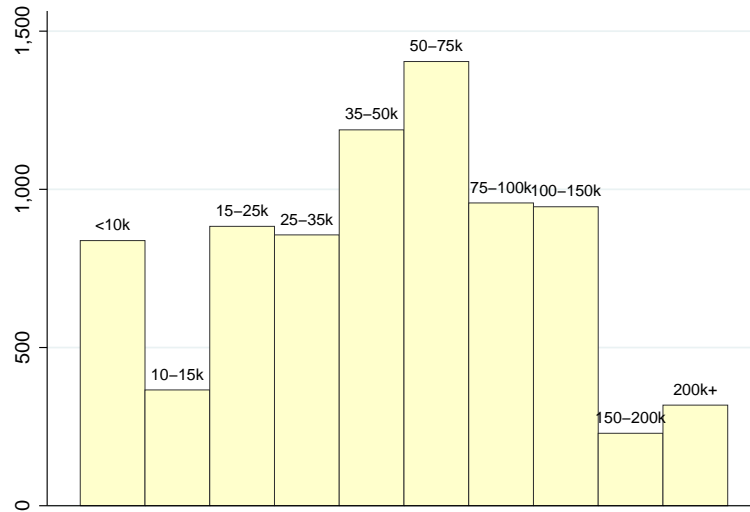

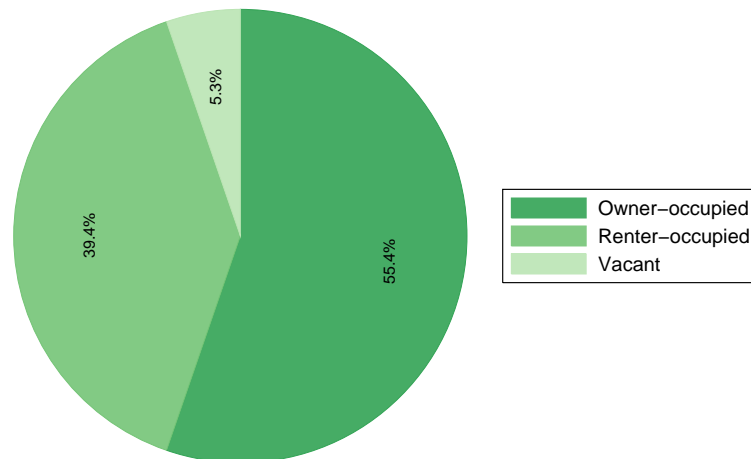
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

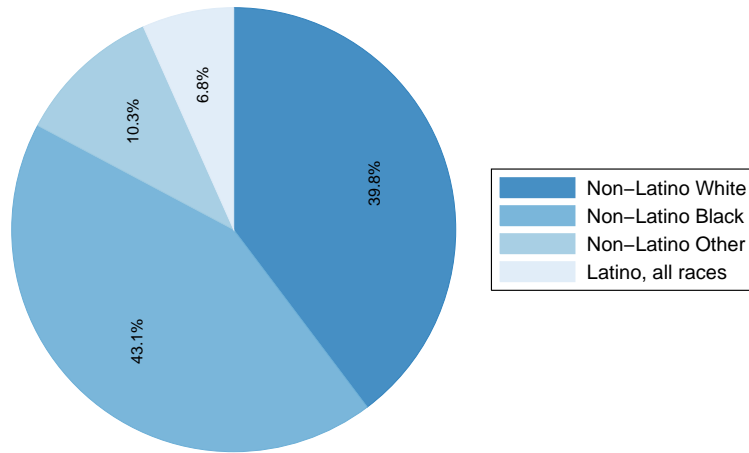

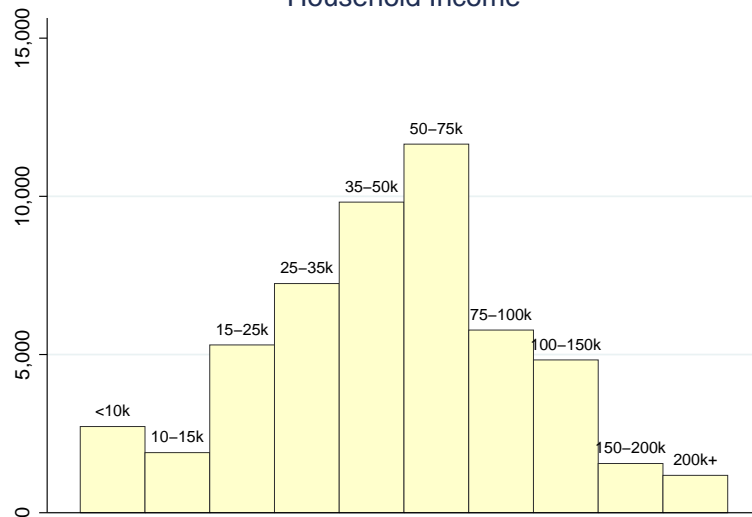

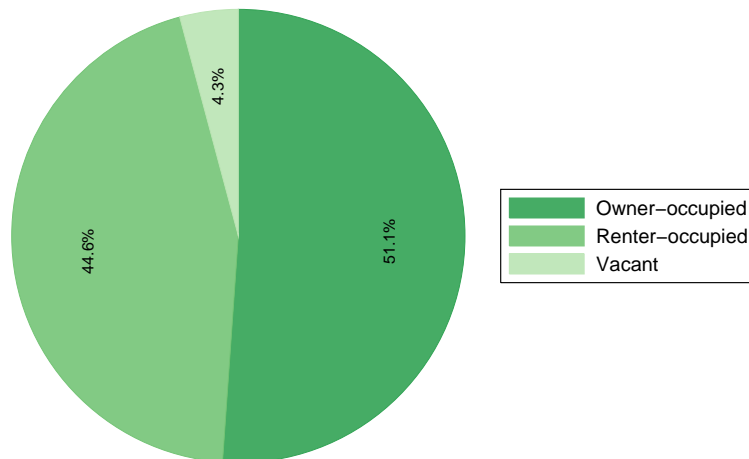
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

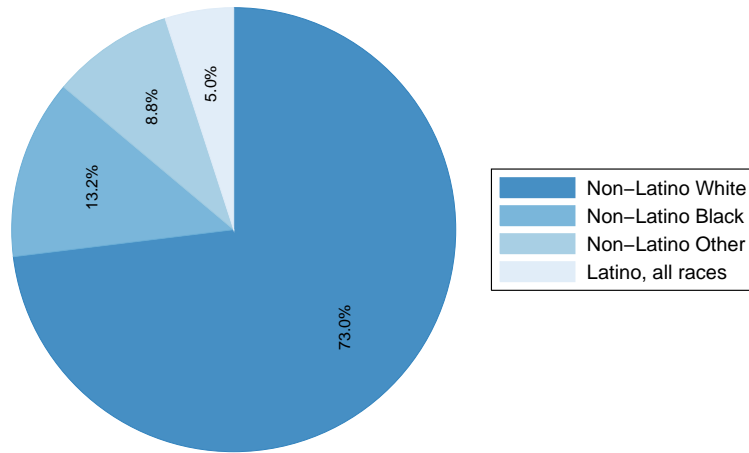

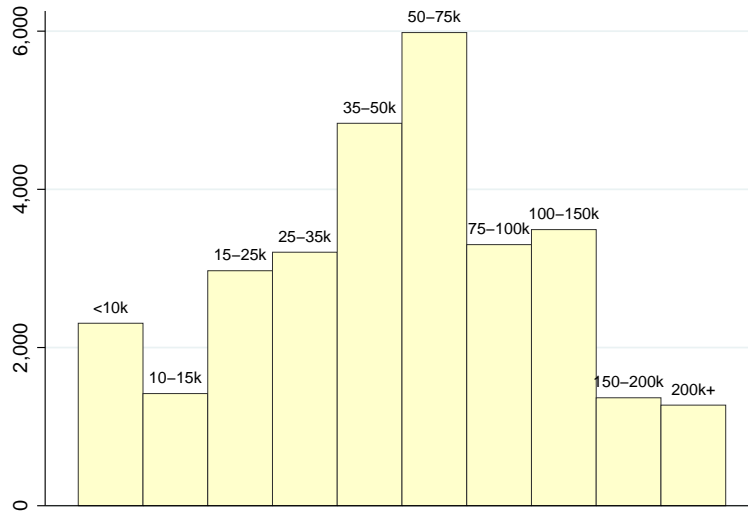

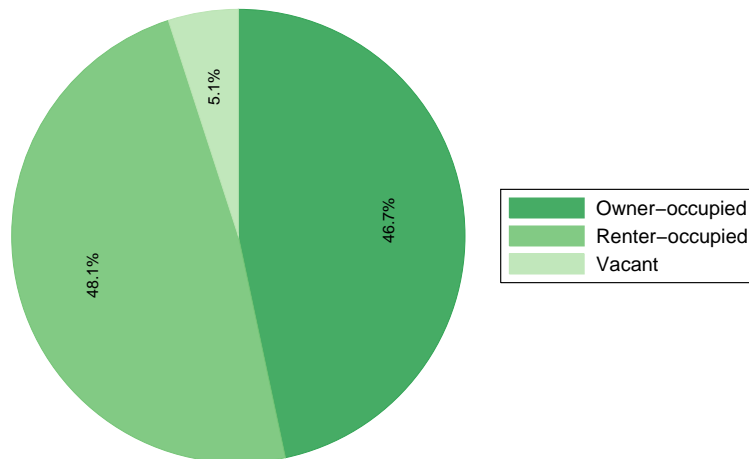
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

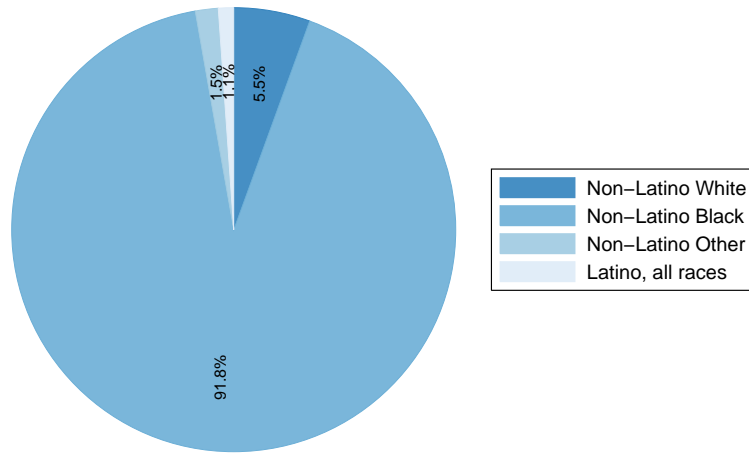

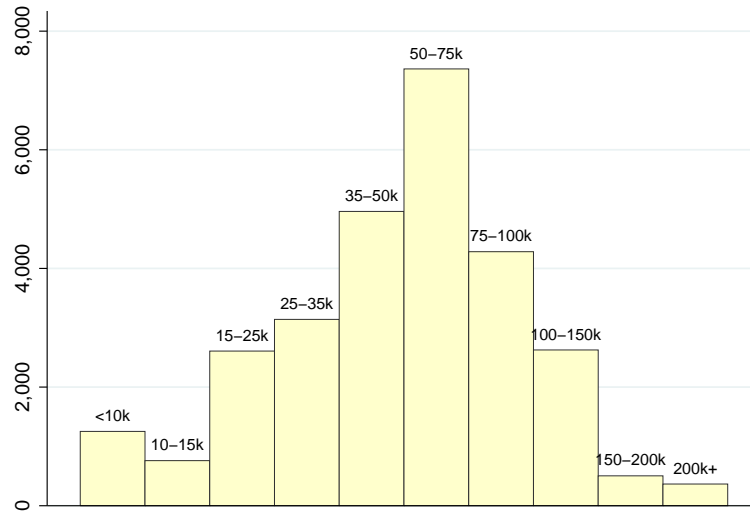

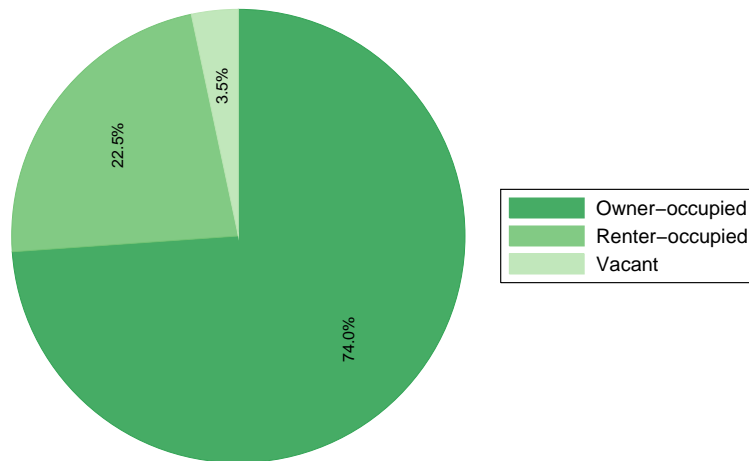
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

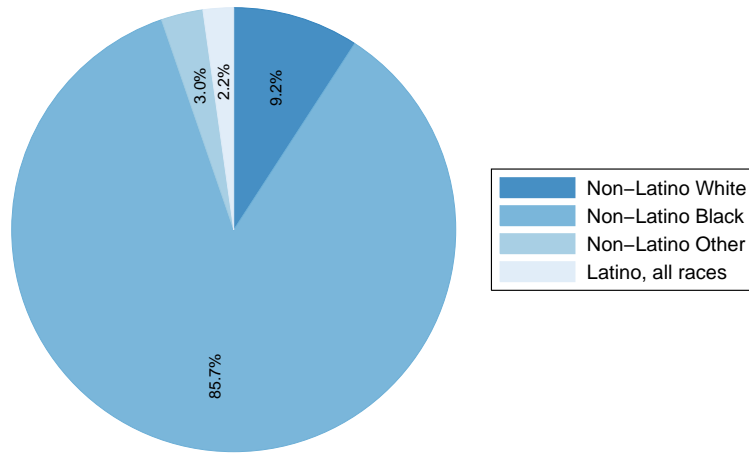

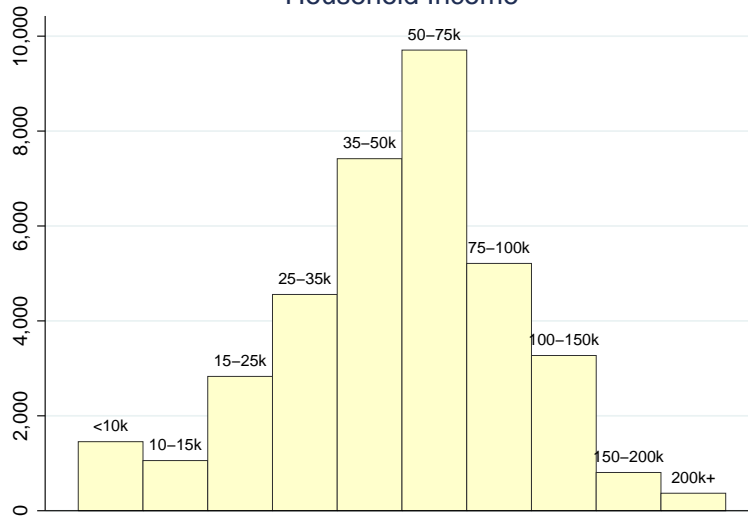

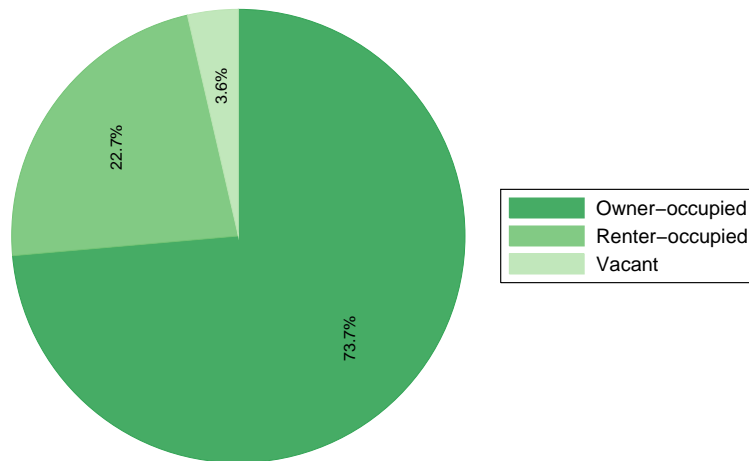
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

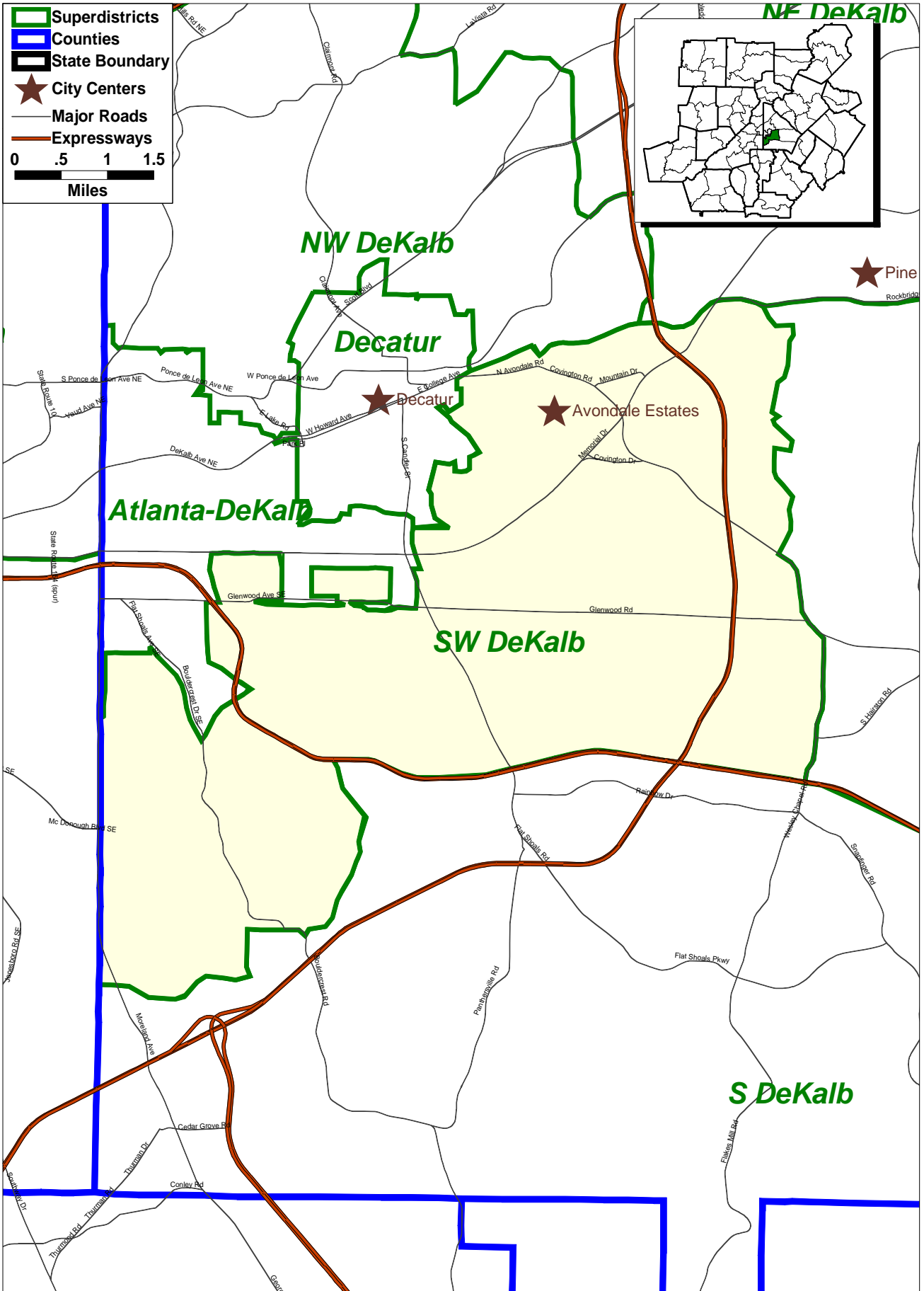

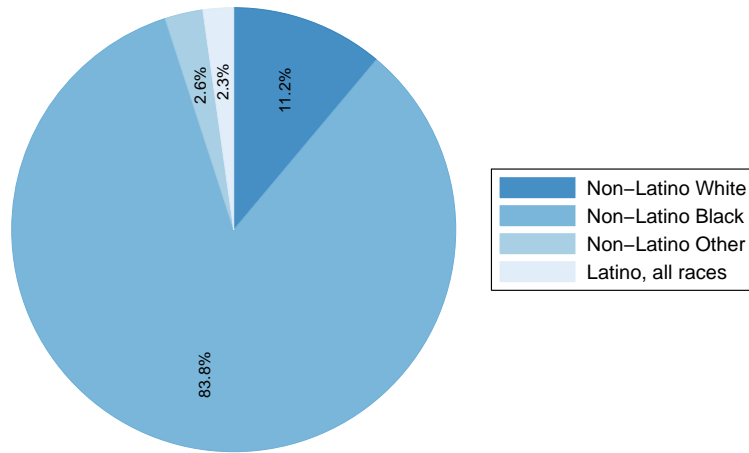

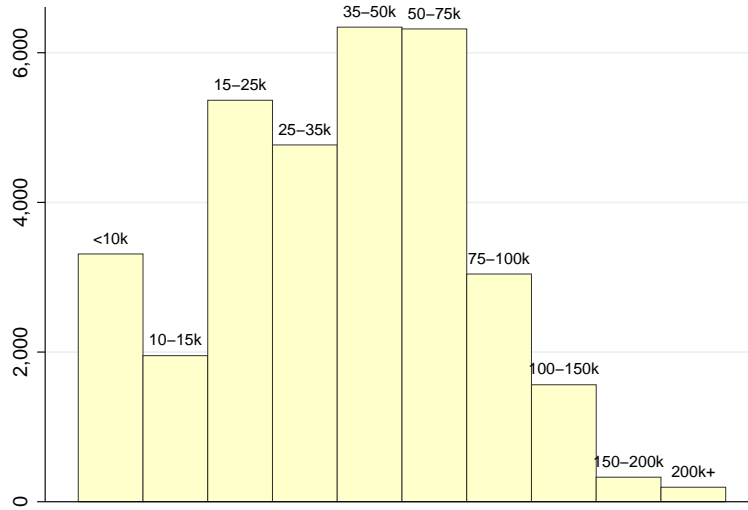

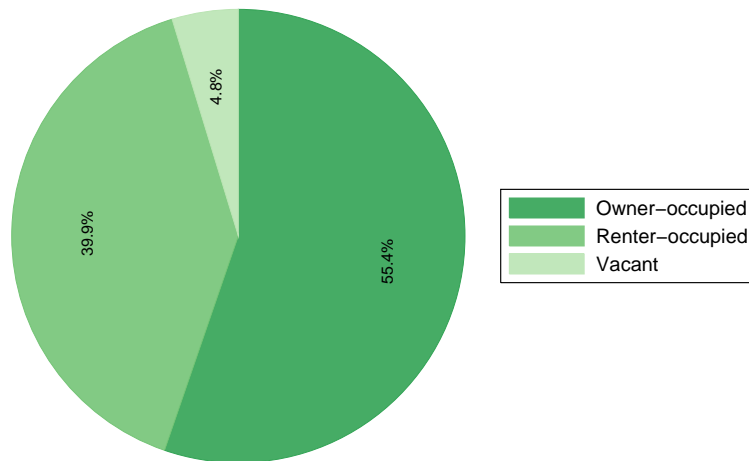
Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin
