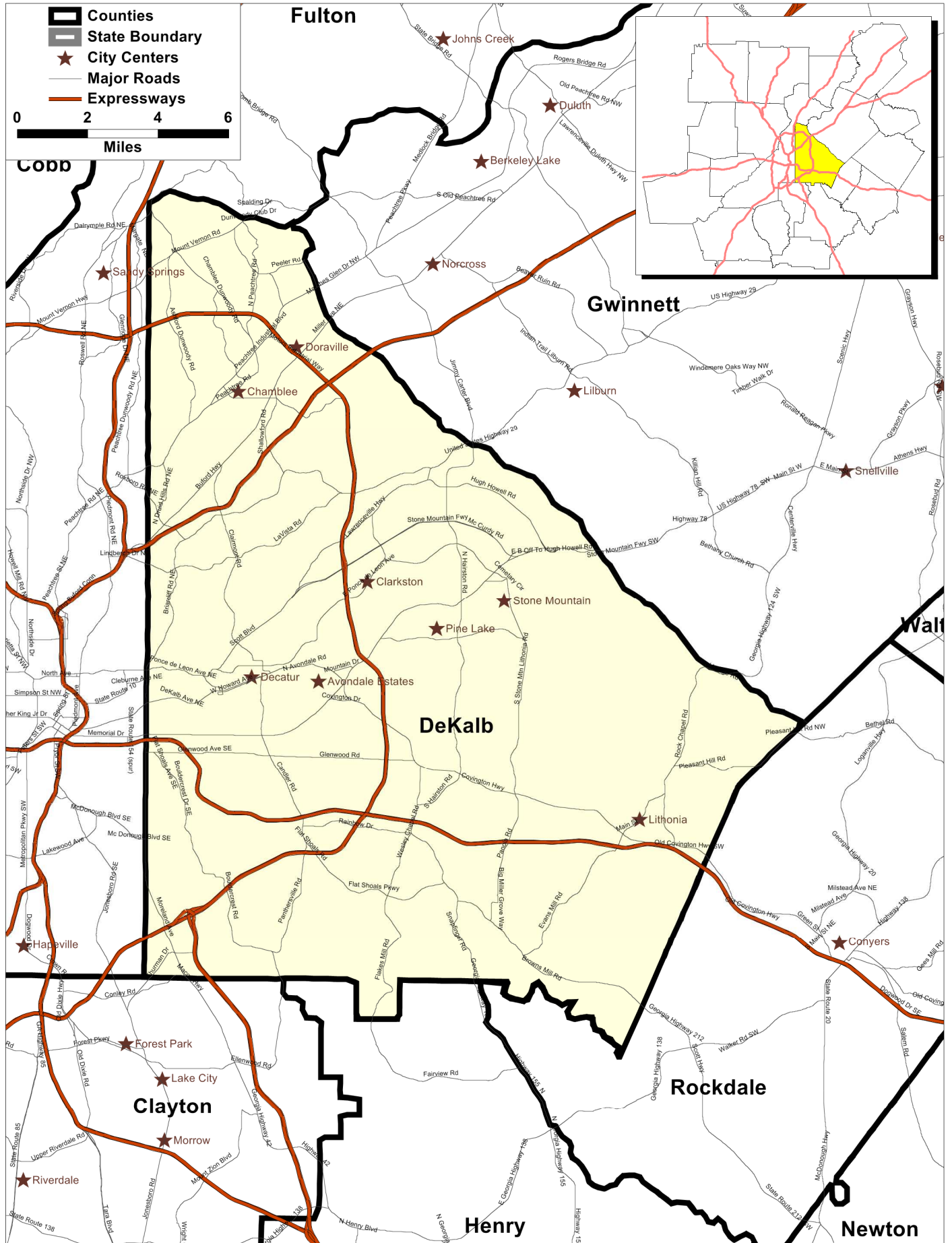
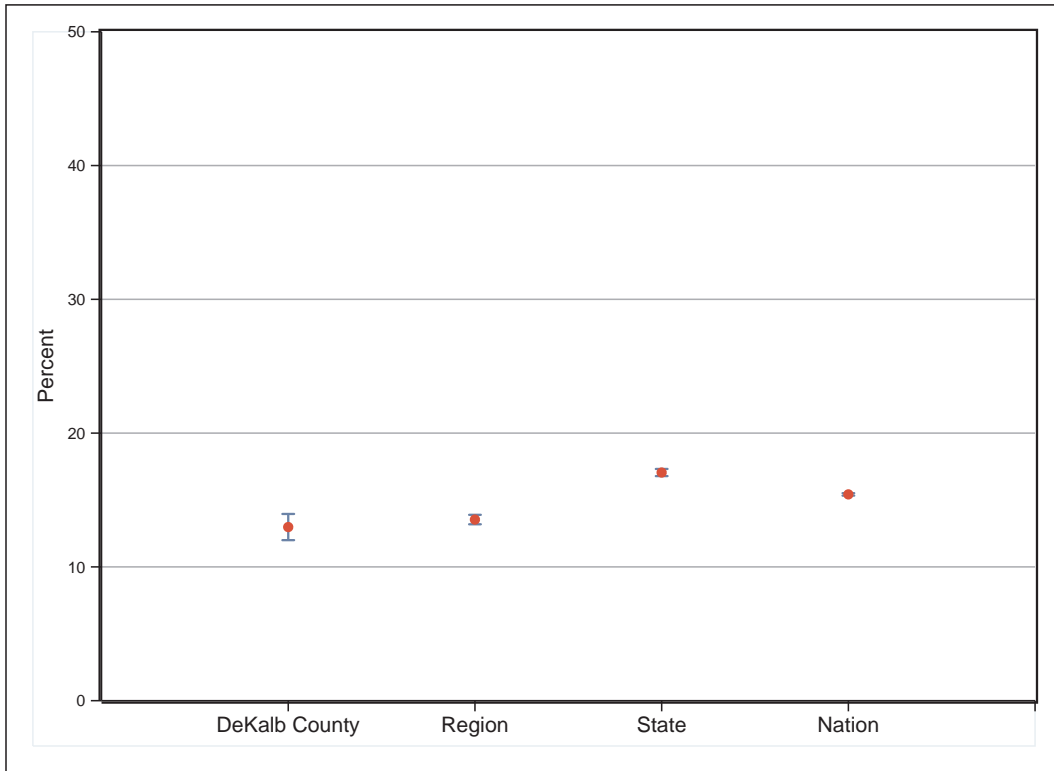


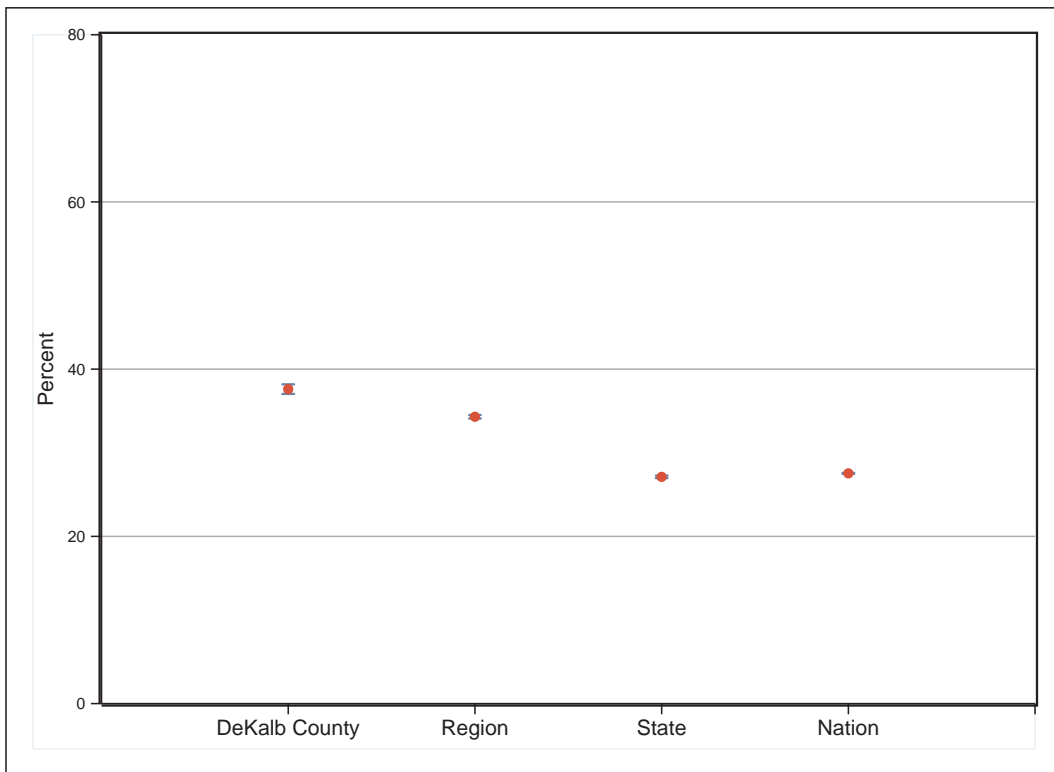

### Percent without a High School Diploma or GED

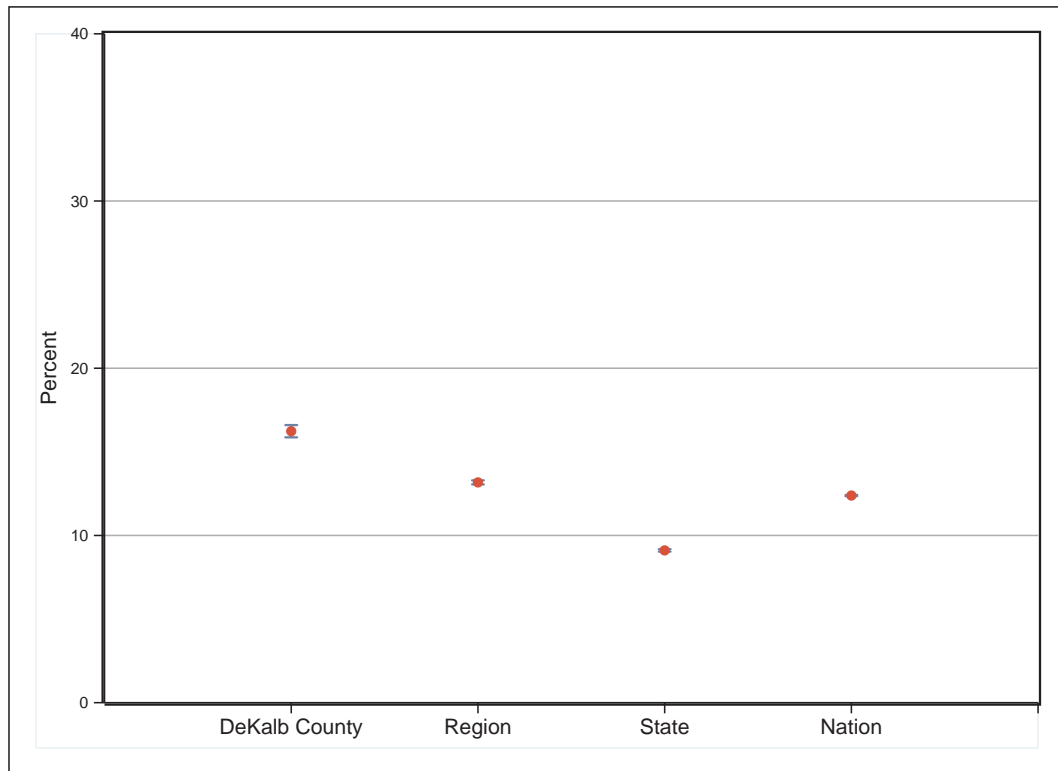


### Percent with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher

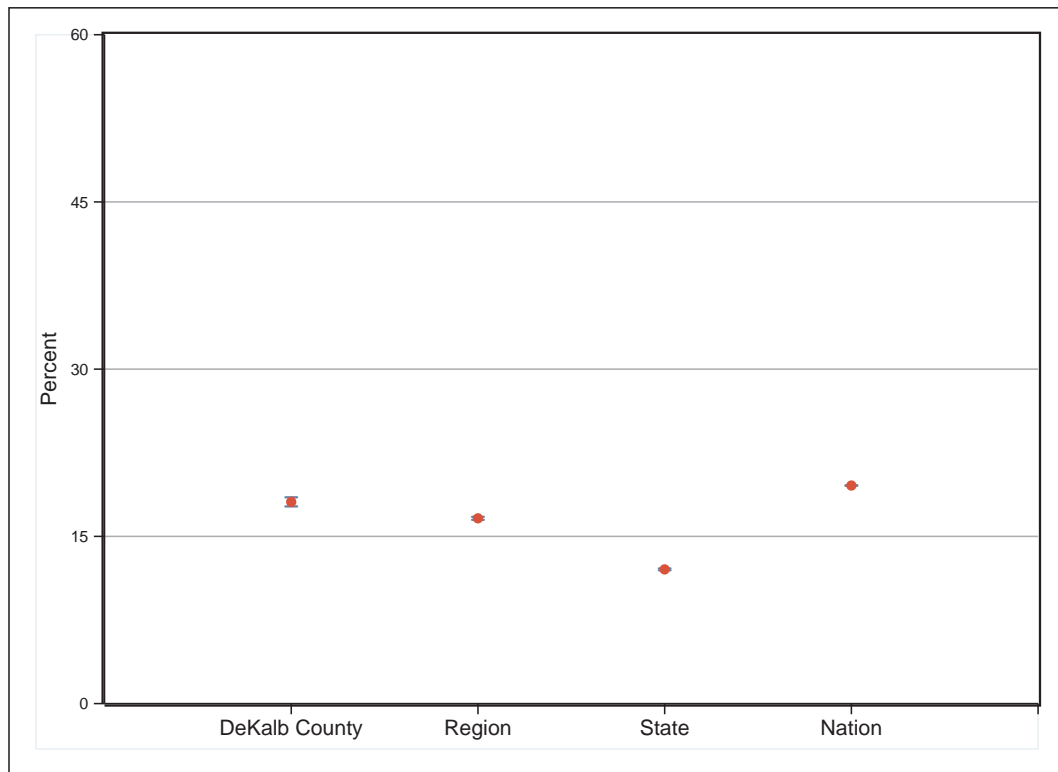

**Percent Foreign-Born**

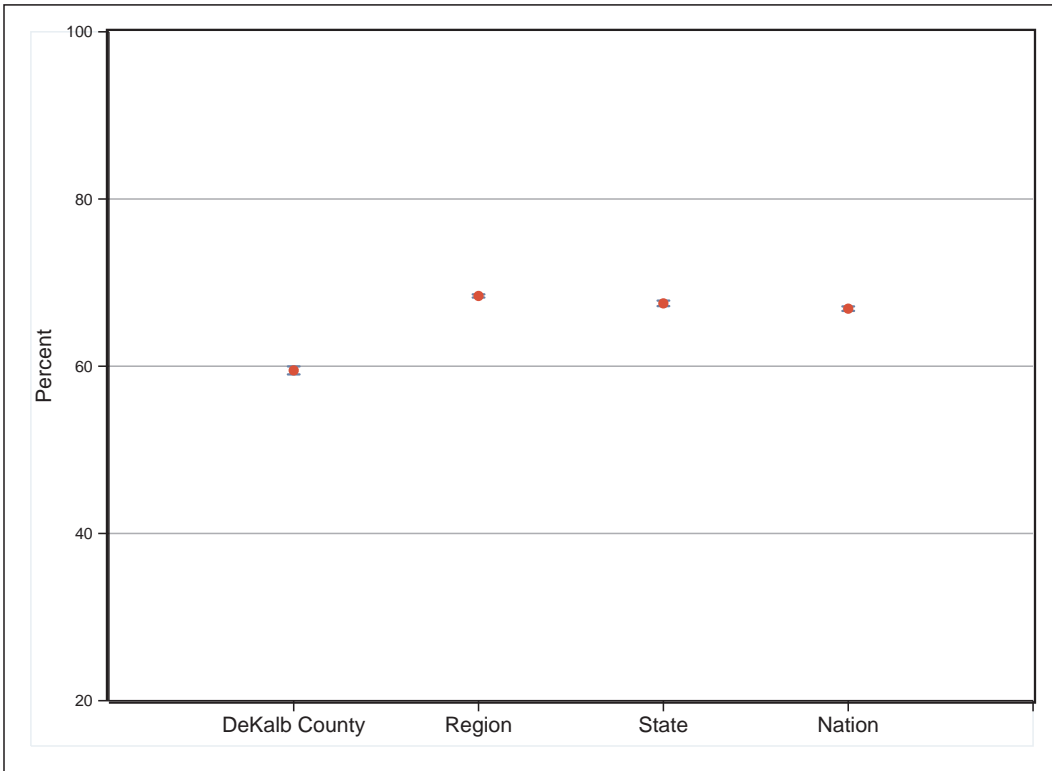


**Percent Speaking a Language other than English at Home**

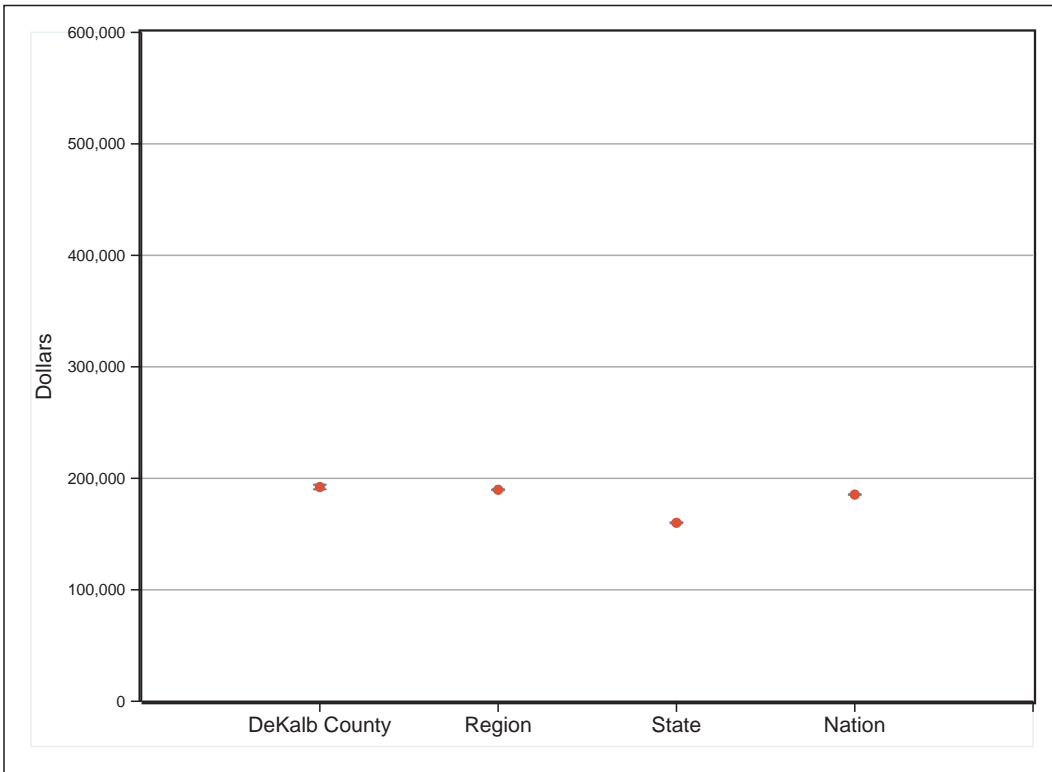

### Percent Owner-Occupied

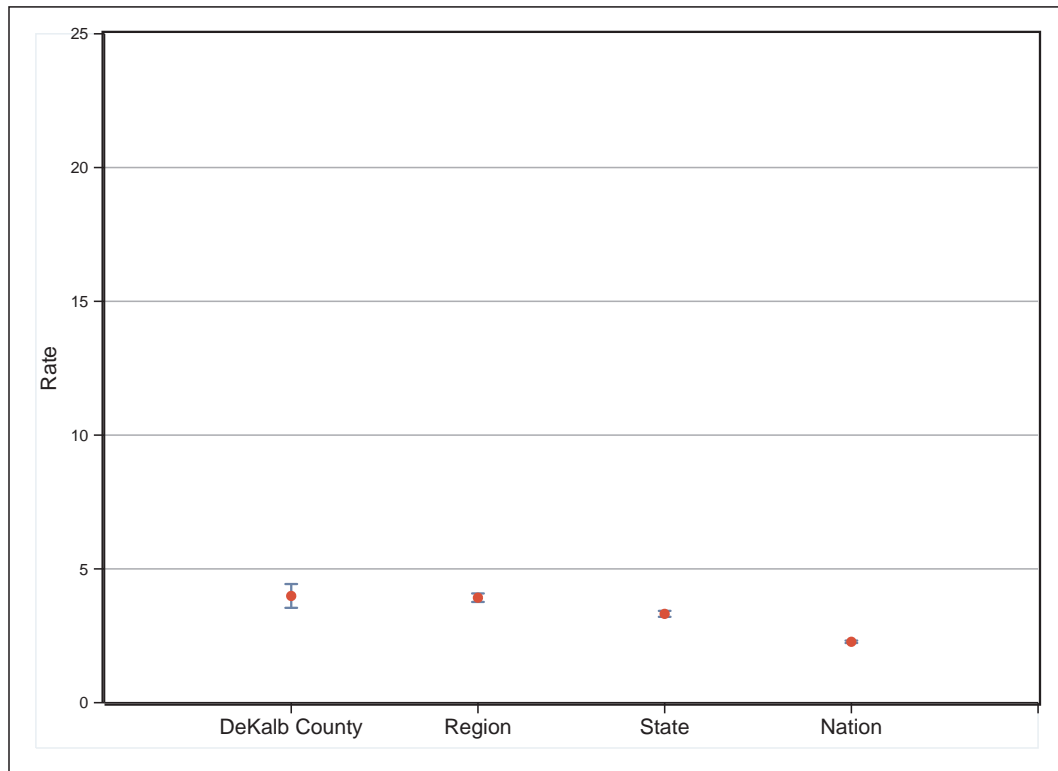


### Median Value of Owner-Occupied Housing Units

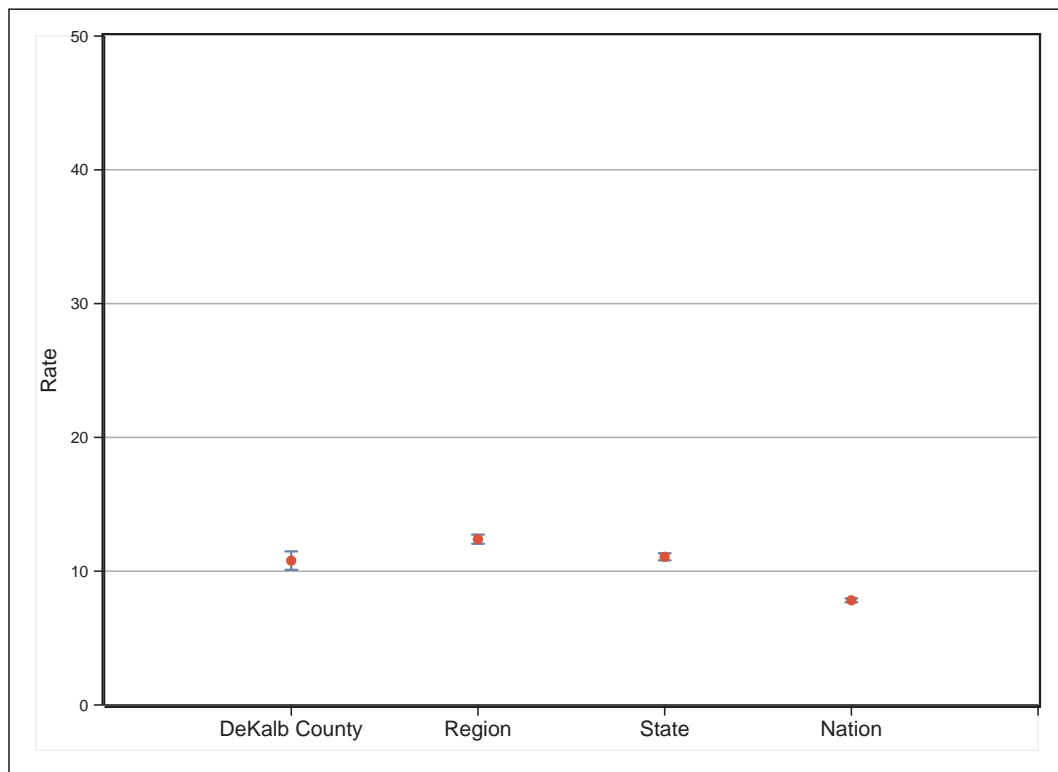

### Homeowner Vacancy Rate

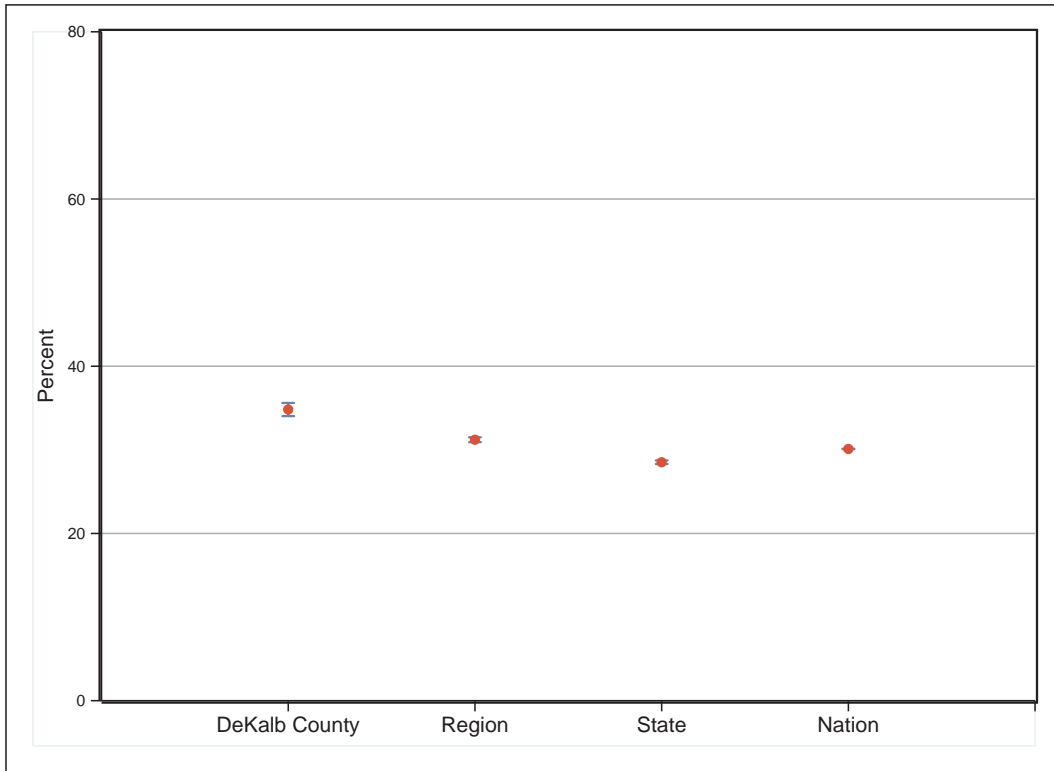


### Rental Vacancy Rate

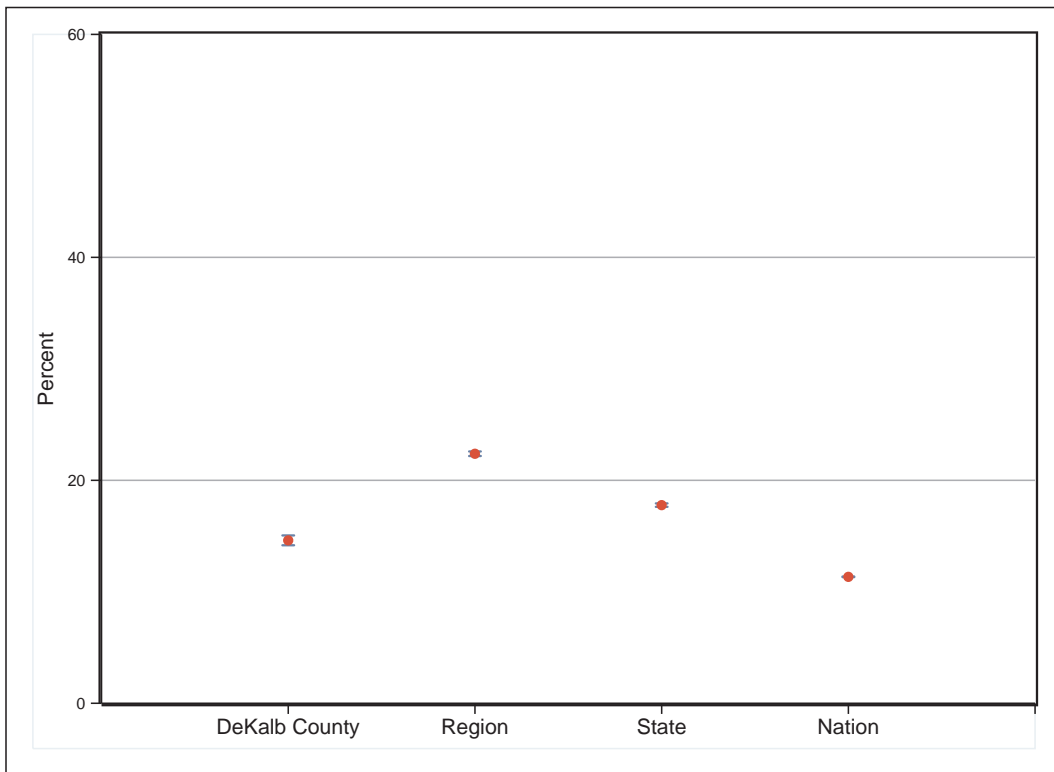

**Percent of Homeowners for whom Selected Monthly Owner Costs Exceed 30% of Income**

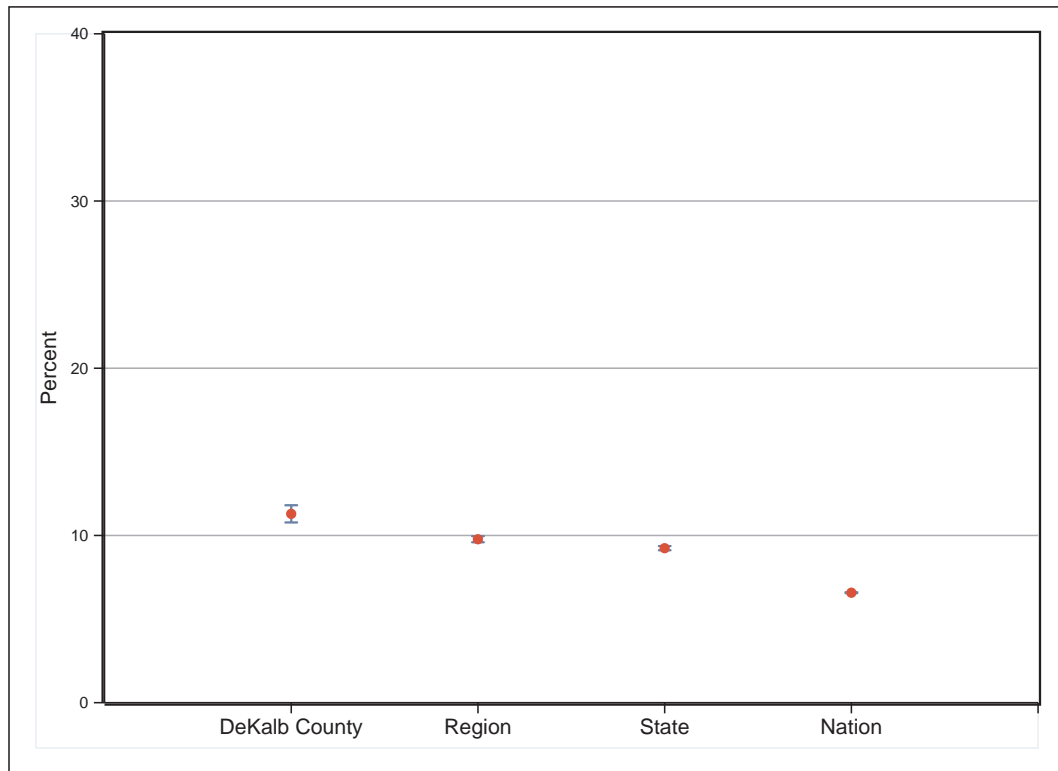


**Percent of Housing Units Built Since 2000**

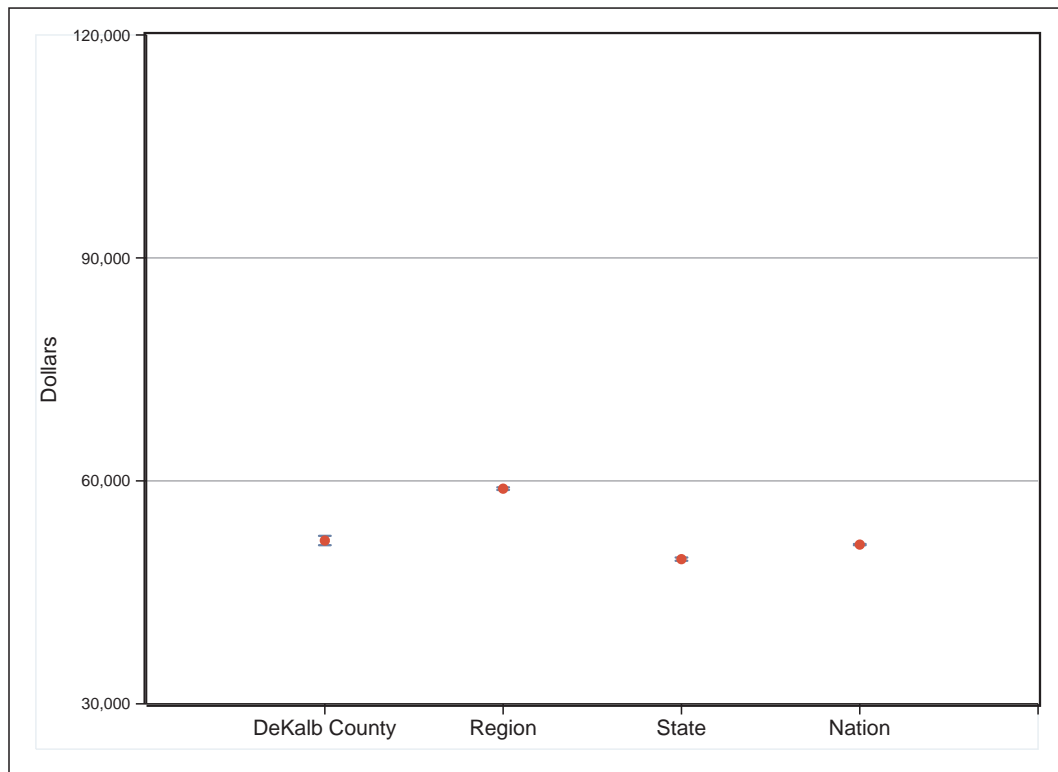

**Percent of Persons Living outside Home County 1 Year Earlier**

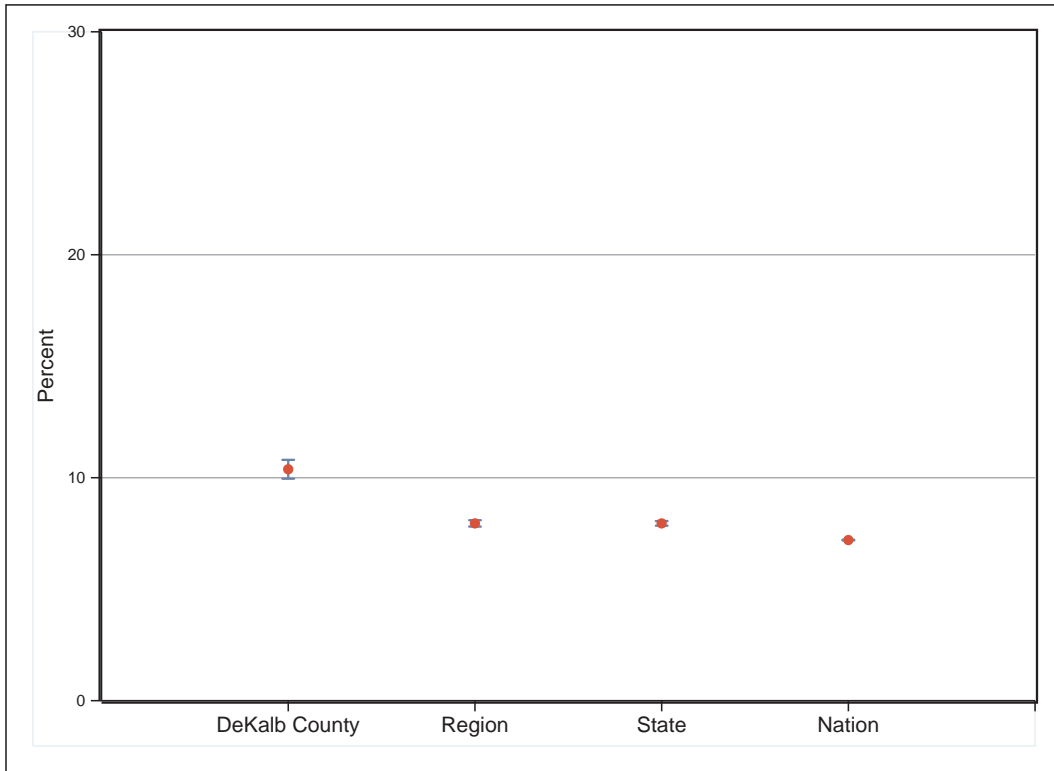


**Median Household Income**

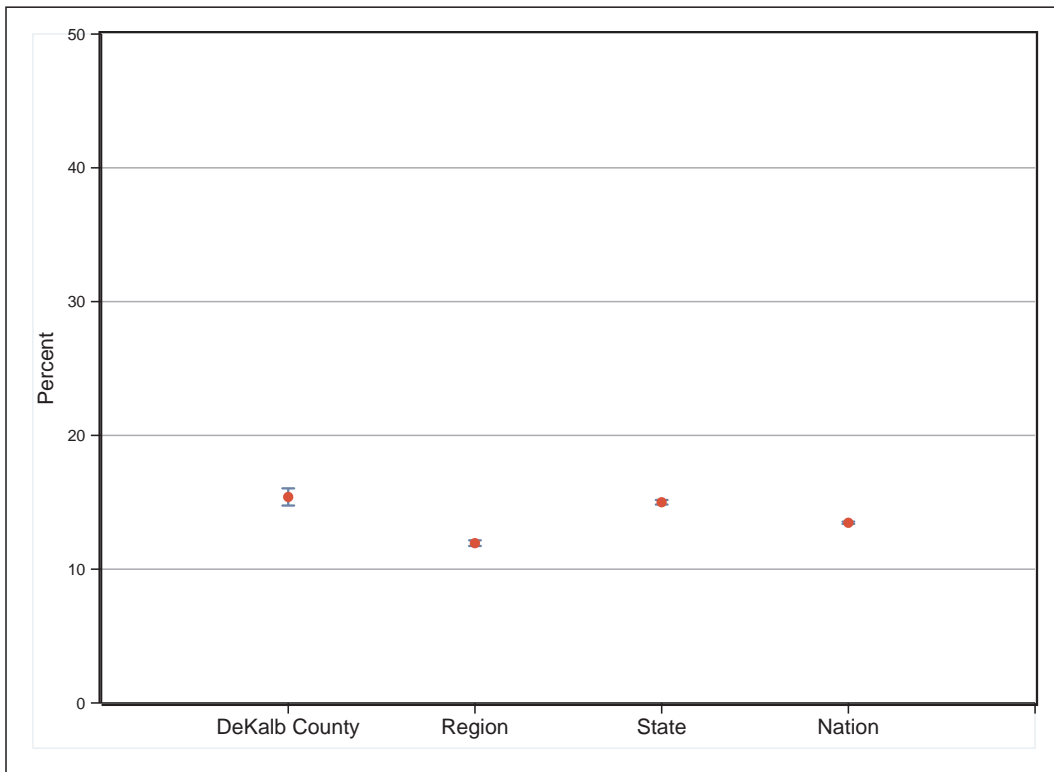
