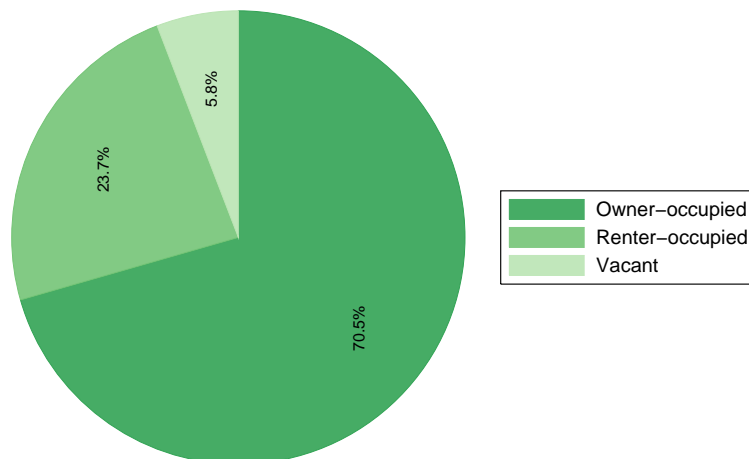
## Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

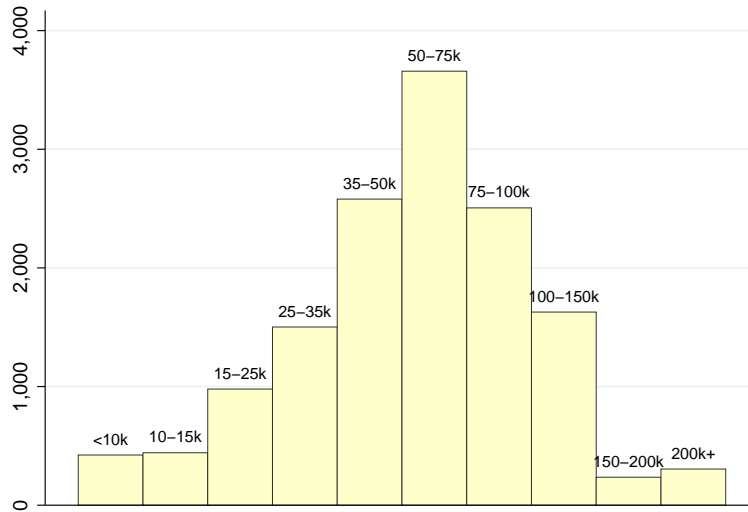

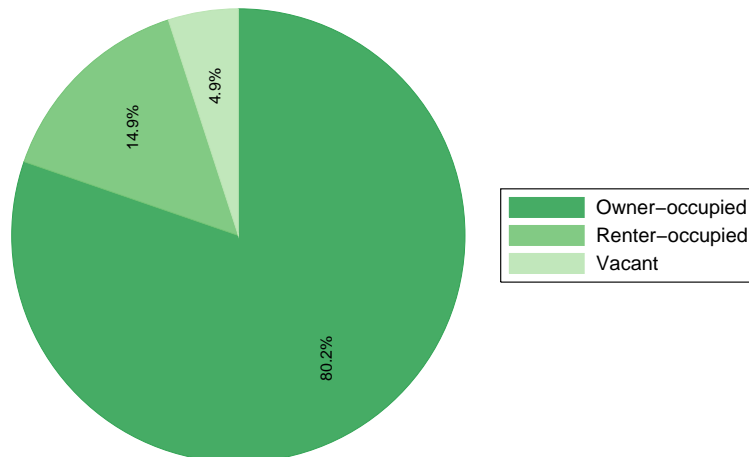
## Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin
