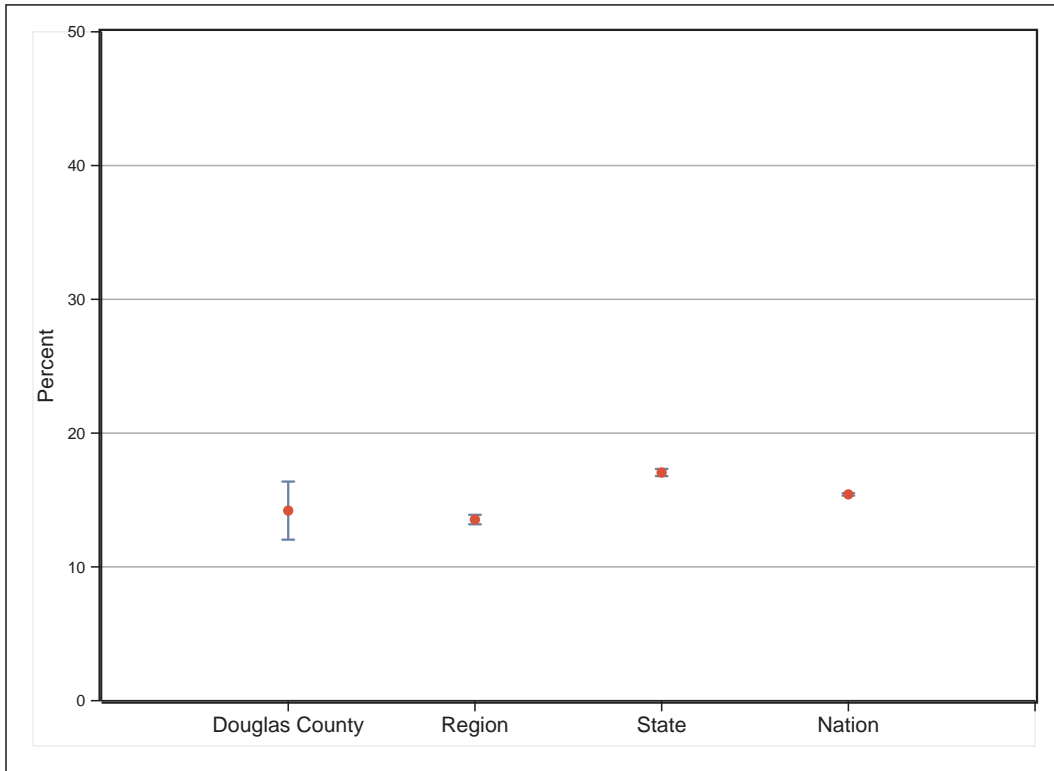
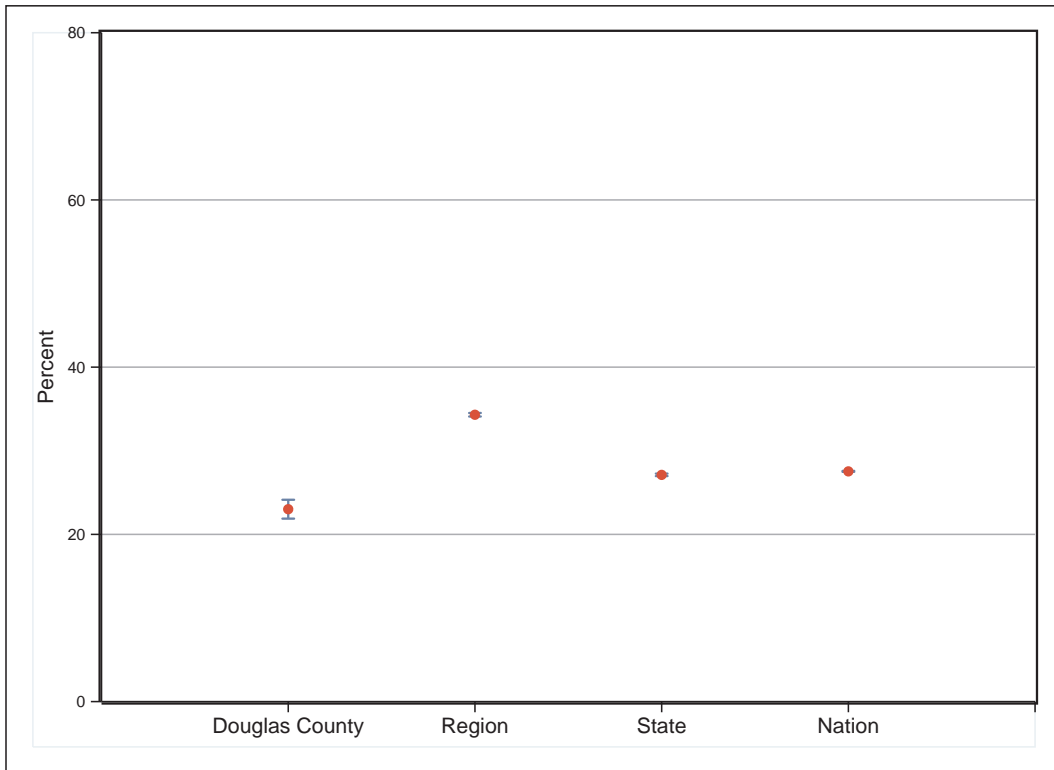


Percent without a High School Diploma or GED

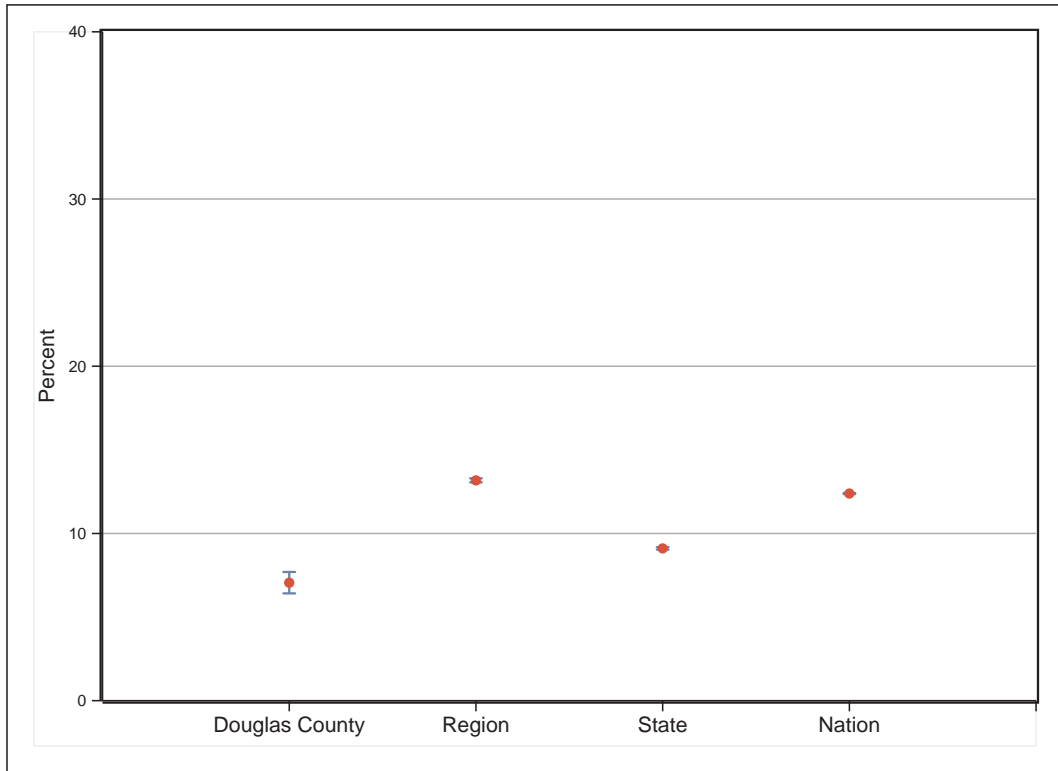


Percent with a Bachelor's Degree or Higher

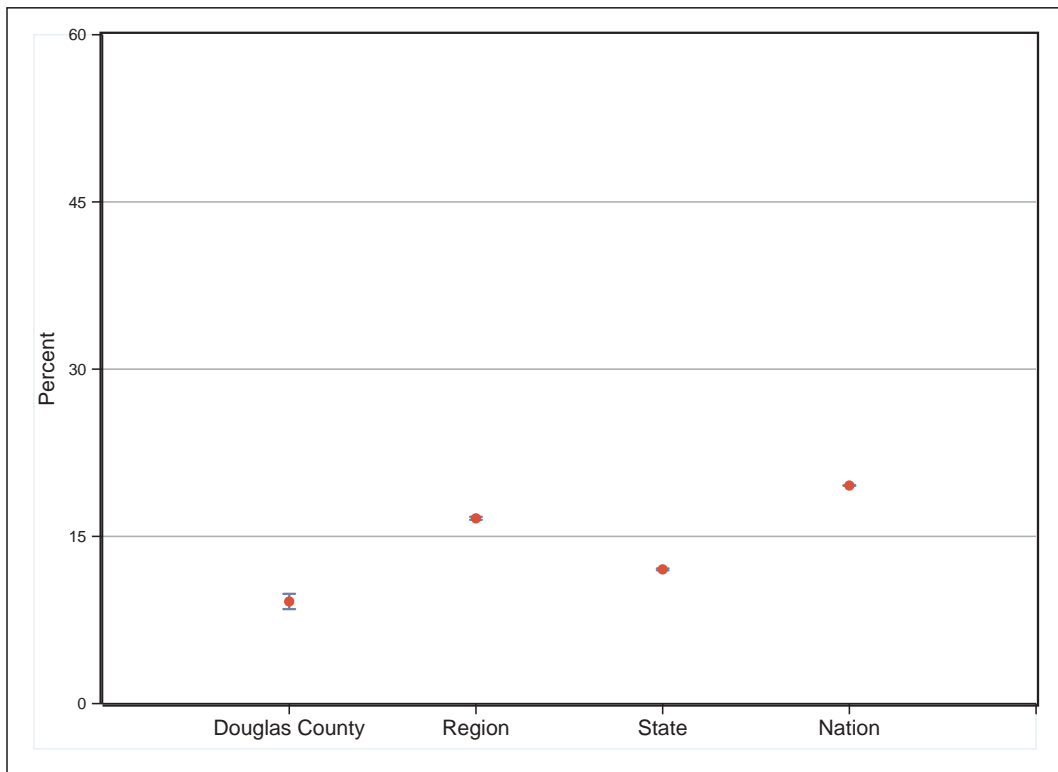

Percent Foreign-Born

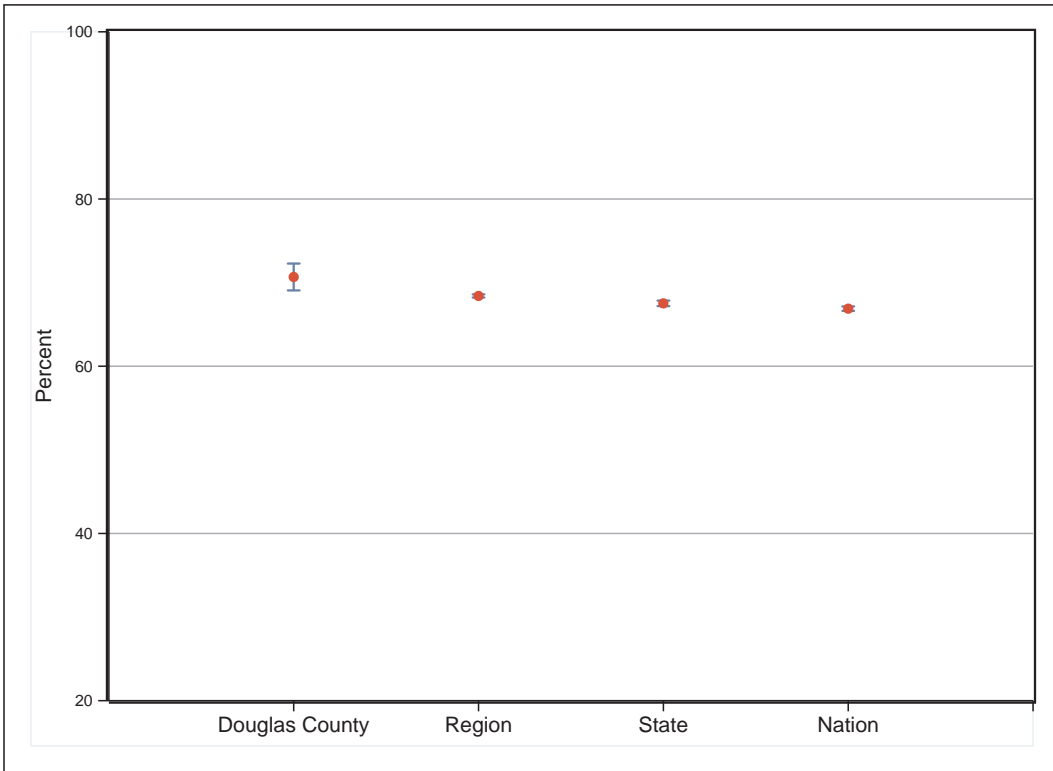


Percent Speaking a Language other than English at Home

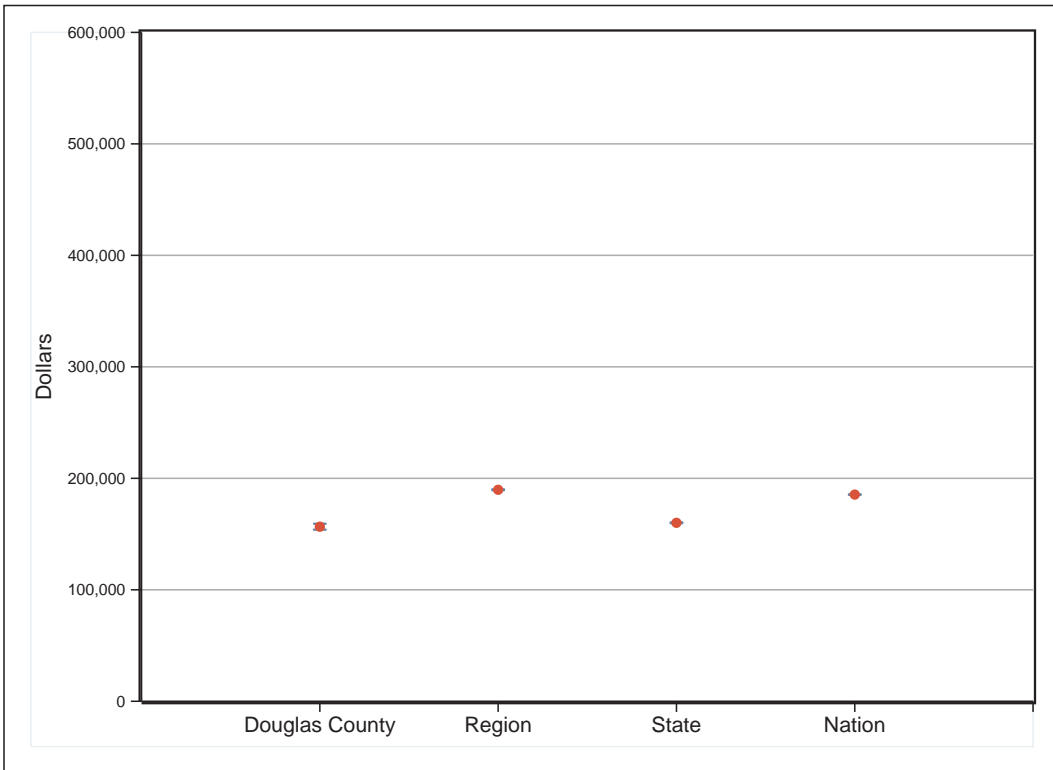

Percent Owner-Occupied

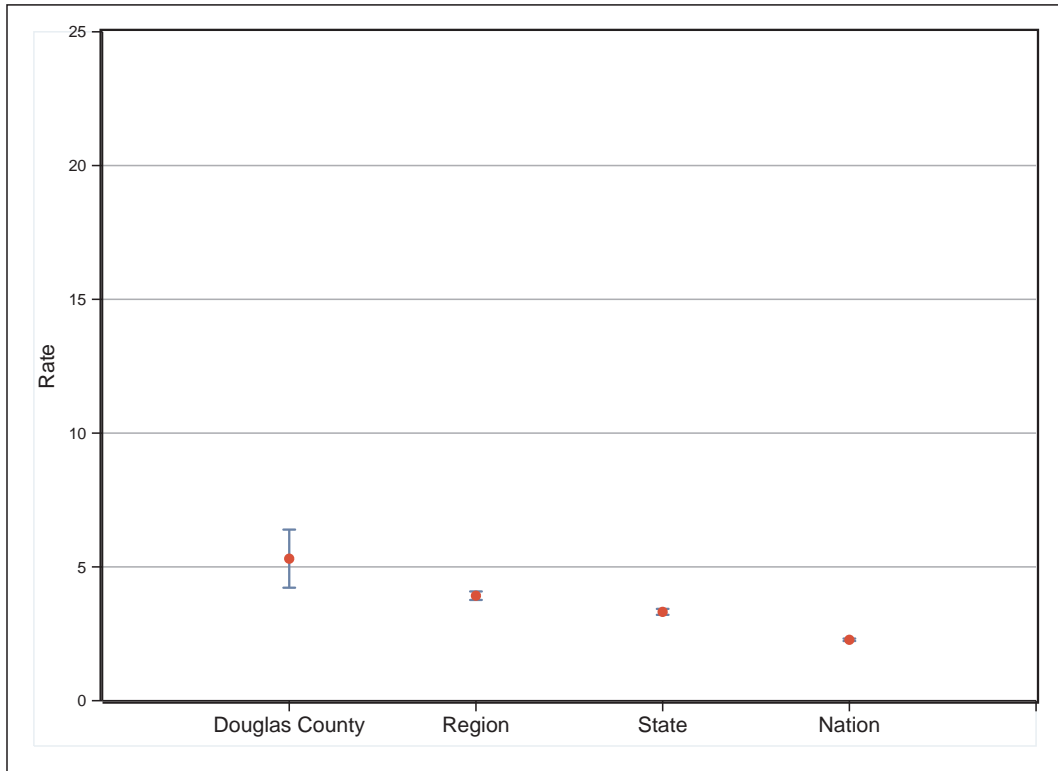


Median Value of Owner-Occupied Housing Units

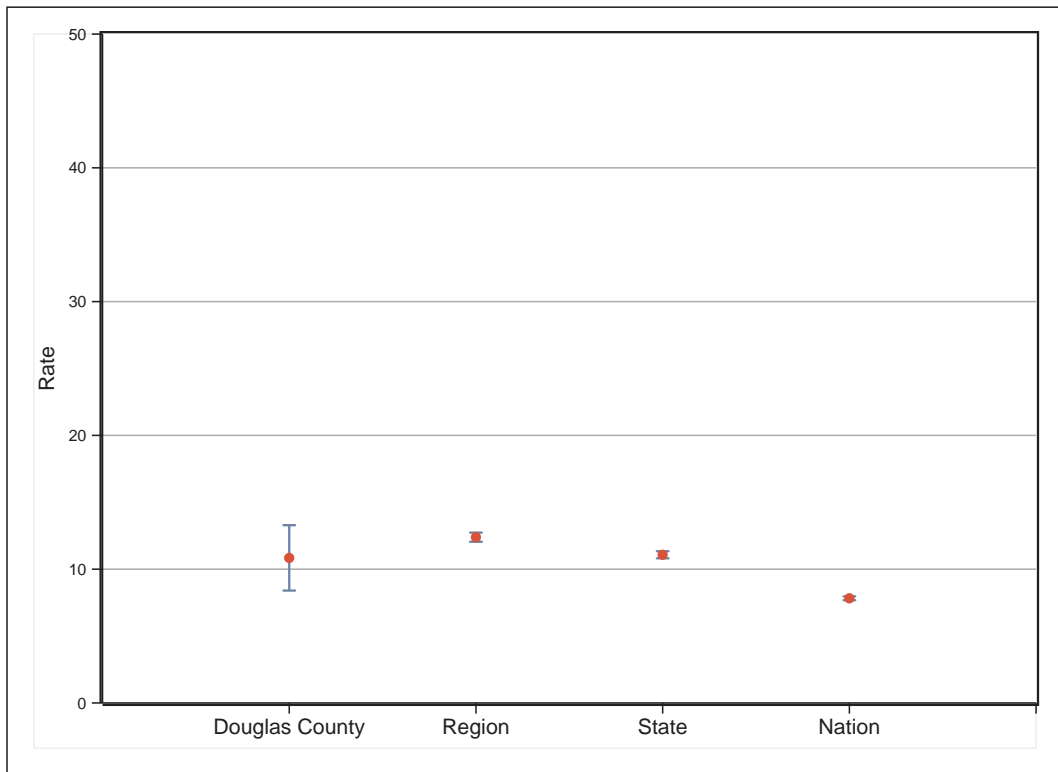

Homeowner Vacancy Rate

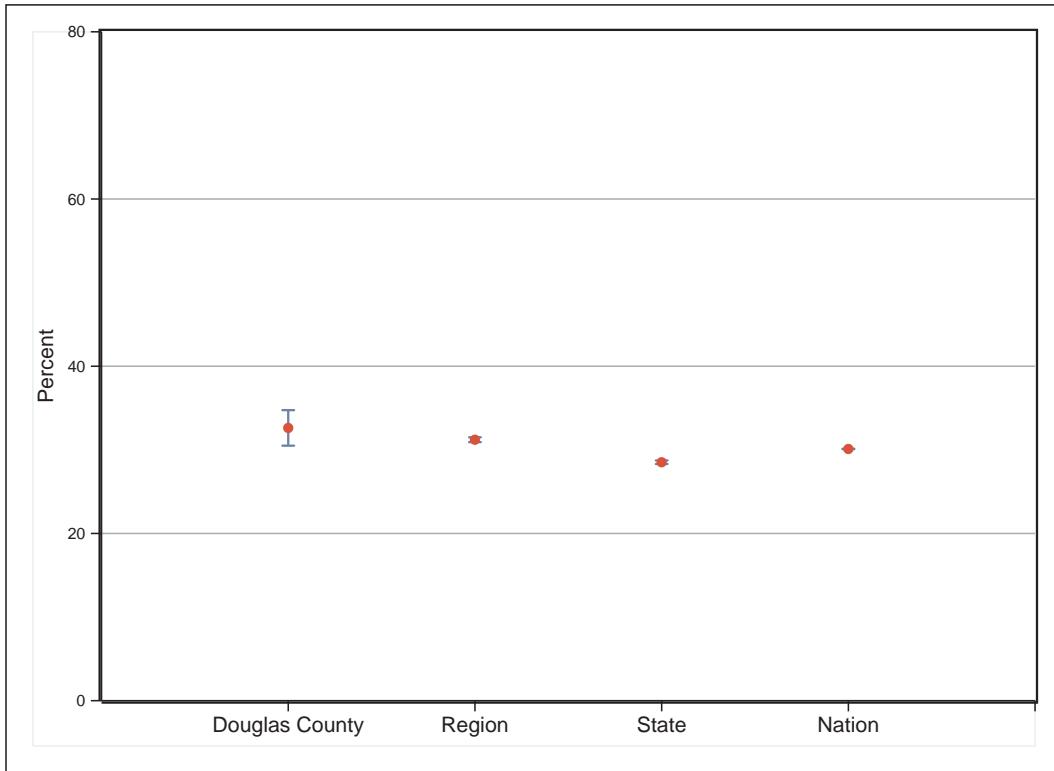


Rental Vacancy Rate

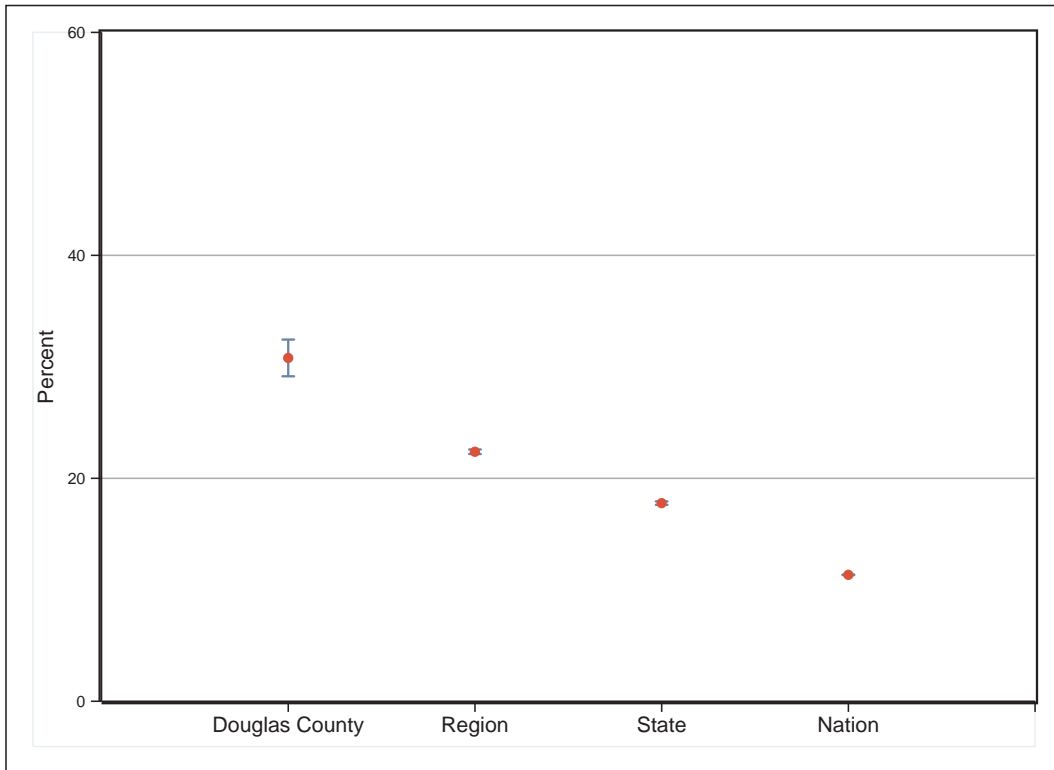

Percent of Homeowners for whom Selected Monthly Owner Costs Exceed 30% of Income

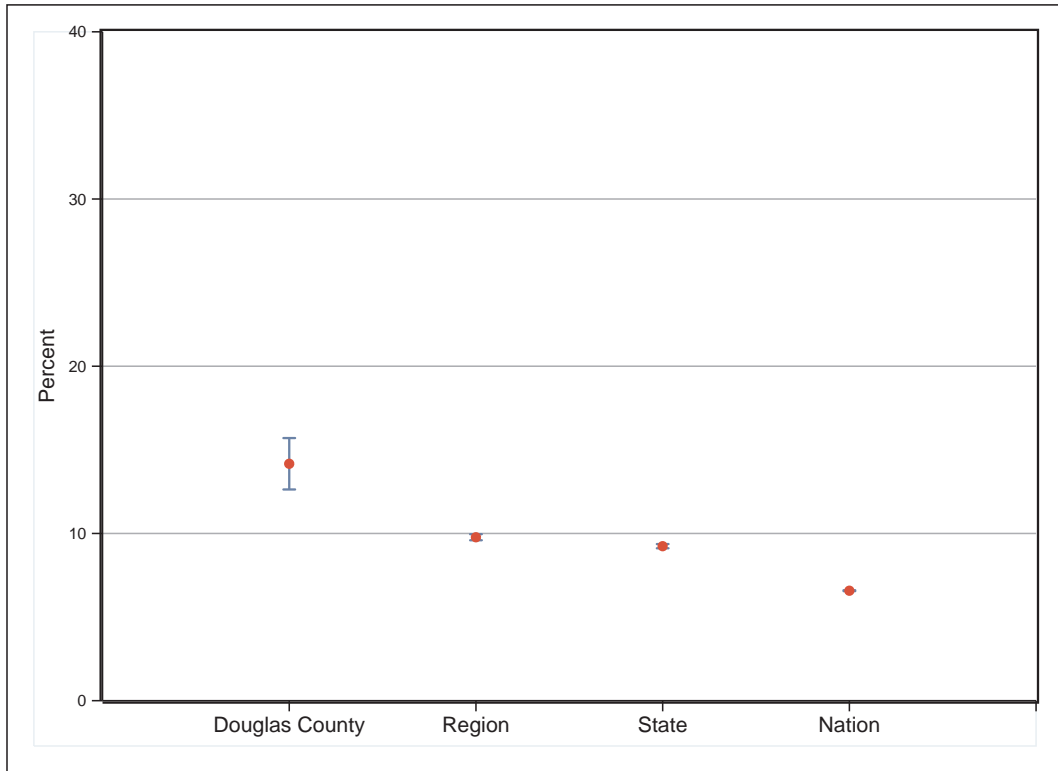


Percent of Housing Units Built Since 2000

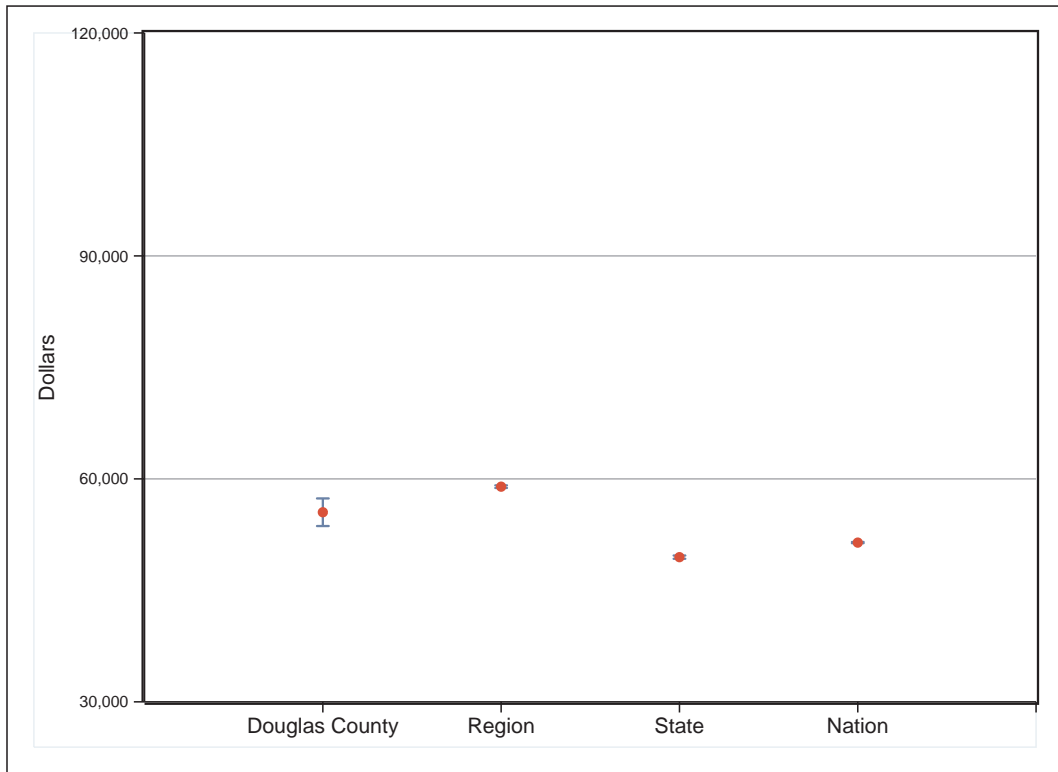

Percent of Persons Living outside Home County 1 Year Earlier

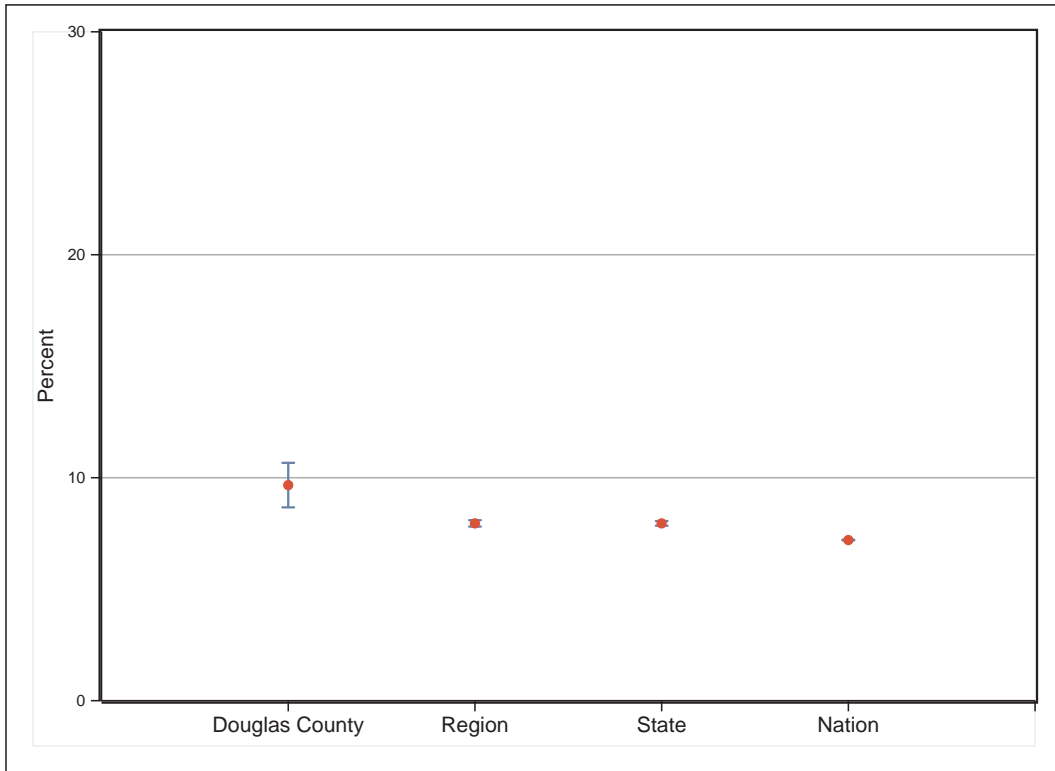


Median Household Income

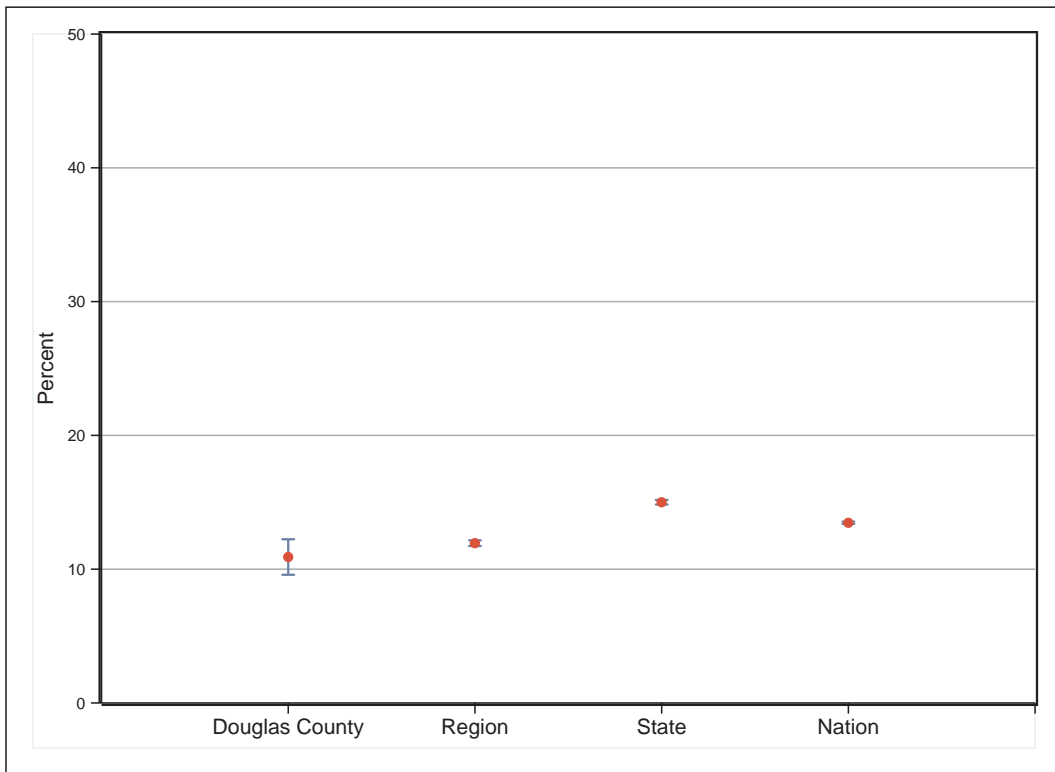
