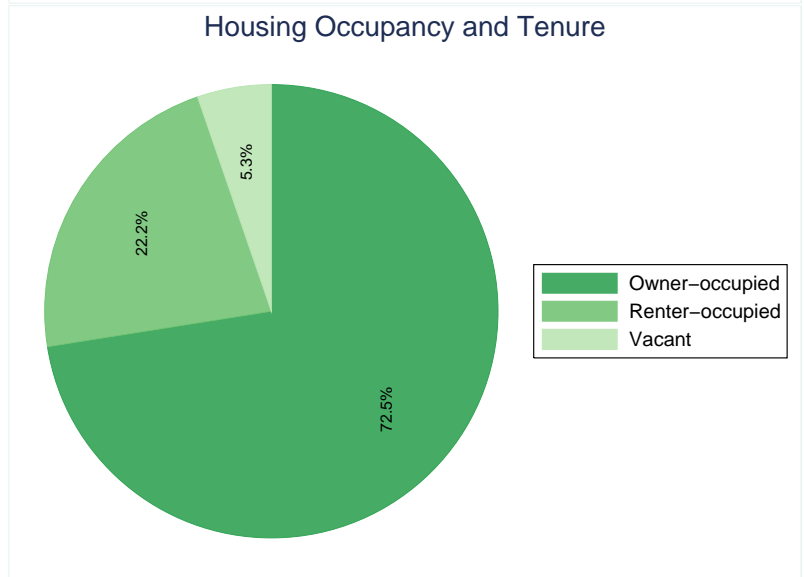
## Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

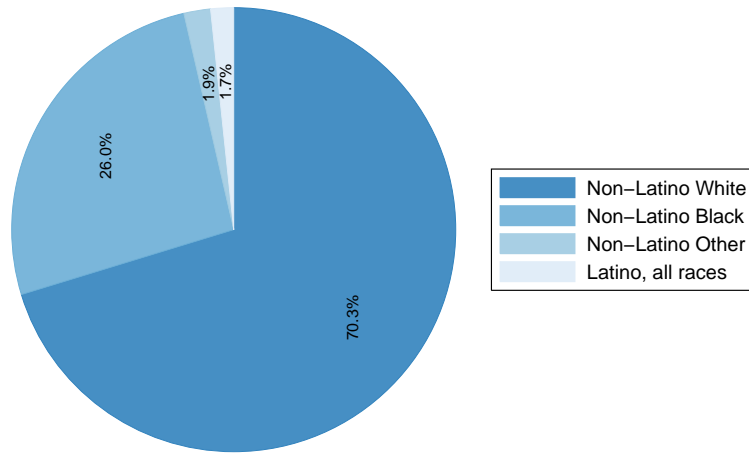

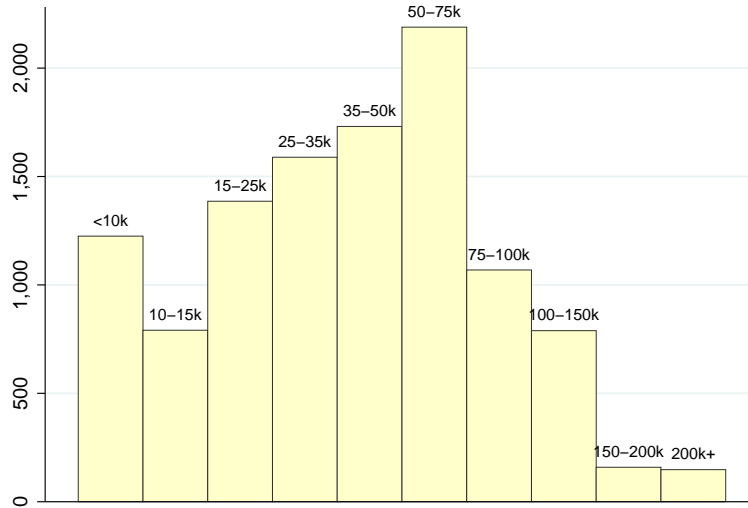

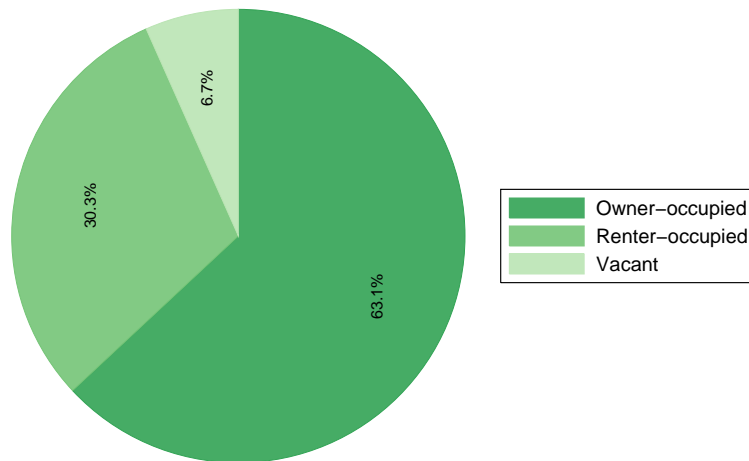
#### Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin

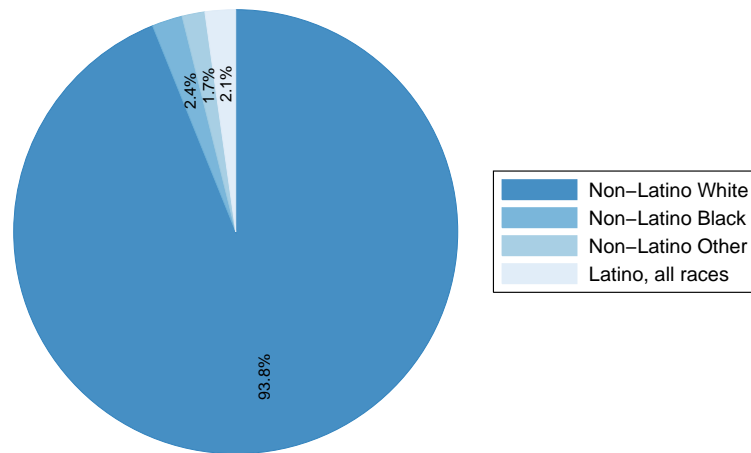

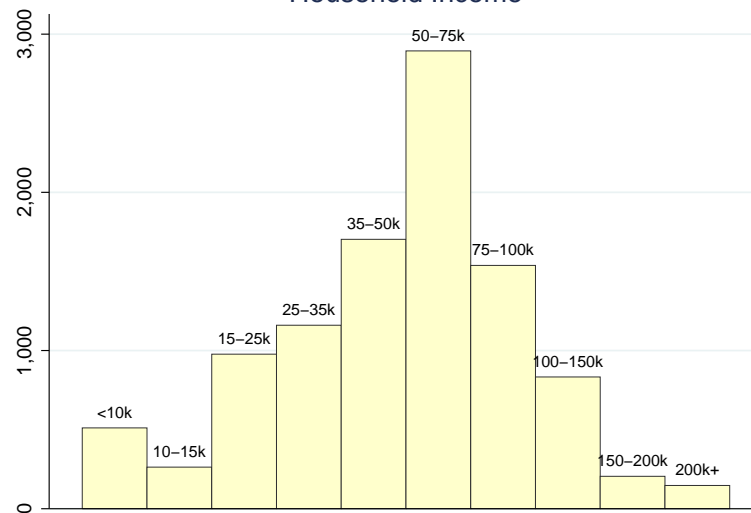

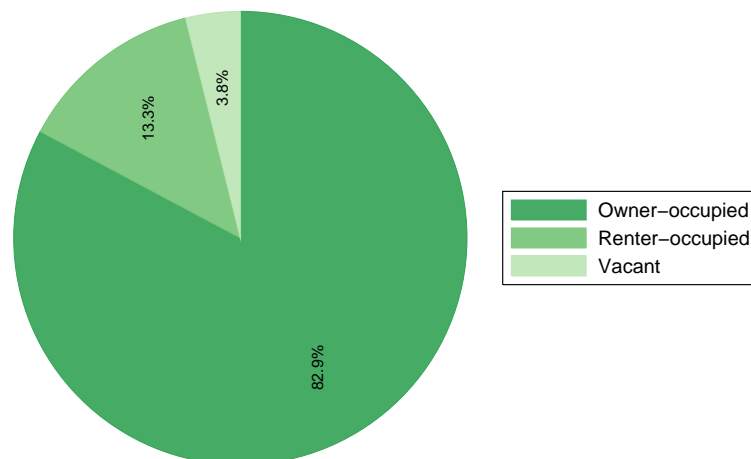
### Race and Hispanic/Latino Origin
